Meeting points

- Mrs Hunter presented the Head Teacher report updating on school progress & events. She shared that Mrs McKenzie is still on secondment and that she will continue in the acting head teacher role.

- Mrs Hunter shared the progress of the chess sessions for P4-P6 and how well it has been doing with great feedback from the children. The school has funded the initial sessions and asked for £360 to run sessions for P3 & P7 in next term. Vote was taken and response was yes to fund the sessions.
- Easy Funding – Joanne updated that she has set up 'easy funding' for the PFA where we will get a % of money that parents & families spend on online purchases simply by clicking a link through from the easy funding app (similar to topcashback or quidco) this is an easy way for parents & families to contribute at no cost to them. Sign up links will be shared shortly.

ACTION – Joanne having account name changed to St Annes PFA then will share links & school will promote on seesaw.

- Rag Bag - Joanne updated to going ahead with having a clothing recycling point outside in the school grounds. PFA would then receive some money per kg of donations. School have confirmed location at ELCC building beside parking spaces.

ACTION - Joanne will progress rag bag application.

- Constitution – voting was discussed. It was felt we should keep votes to within meetings for PFA group decisions, in line with other parent councils & where bigger full school opinions were needed we would survey all parents & families use online polls etc to get full class representation & opinion.
- Daniella provided a financial update. We made £226 from the Christmas card money so now have a total of £1953 in the bank.

- Parent council using seesaw to communicate was discussed. Was shared that other schools use this & reaches every family.
- Joint ELCC/School/Church fundraising was discussed.

ACTION – Jennifer will speak to church fundraising group.

- Vote -Race night- vote was to postpone until next school year.
- Future fundraising – spring raffle was discussed, apply for licence and hope to do online. Will continue discussion at next meeting.
