Summer Weather

Please ensure sunscreen is applied to your child prior to attending nursery and that weather appropriate clothing is worn as your children will be involved in outdoor learning every day.

Absences

Please remember to phone the nursery mobile if your child will be absent from nursery, thank you.

Password

If you are not collecting your child from nursery and it is not someone we know we will ask you to provide a password. The password will change each time this happens.

Your child should come to nursery with their favourite teddy and £1 we will have a lovely picnic and some games outside. This of course as always is optional. Child's Plans

You will be asked to meet with our Senior Nursery Officer Teresa Marklow to complete this within one month of your child's start date. This appointment will take 20-30 minutes.

We would like to invite you to join our Nursery Parent Committee. This will allow you to be consulted on up and coming events and issues relevant to the life of our nursery. It will allow staff and parents to work in collaboration and get to know each other even better.
