# **School Registration**

Registration for children due to begin school in August 2016 will take place on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2017 (A-L) and Thursday 12 January 2017 (M-Z) from 1.00pm - 3.00pm. Children must be enrolled for school using the name which appears on the birth certificate, which must be produced at the time of registration. The school handbook will be available at this time for anyone who wishes a copy. Please see information on nursery door.
