School Registration

Registration for children who reach 5 years of age between 1st March 2018 and 28th February 2019 will take place on Wednesday 10th January 2018 (Surnames A-L) and Thursday 11th January 2018 (Surnames M-Z) from 1.00pm - 3.00pm. Children must be enrolled for school using the name which appears on the birth certificate, which must be produced at the time of registration. Two proofs of residence should be produced, which must include council tax notice for the property or proof that you have registered for council tax for that property, and a letter from your solicitor confirming that missives have been concluded or a rent book for a rented property, tenancy agreement or mortgage/bank statement. The school handbook will be available at this time for anyone who wishes a copy.



Weather

Please ensure that weather appropriate clothing is worn as your children will be involved in outdoor learning every day. As the weather can be very cold at this time of year a waterproof jacket, hat, scarf and gloves and sensible footwear should be worn. Providing your child with a change of shoes to leave in nursery would be very much appreciated.

Absences

Please remember to phone the nursery mobile if your child will be absent from nursery, thank you.

<u>Password</u>

If you are not collecting your child from nursery and it is not someone we know we will ask you to provide a password. The password will change each time this happens.
