On the days where your child has PE we ask that they bring/ wear a school polo shirt, shorts and soft shoes. For health and safety reasons no jewellery should be worn during PE including earrings. In the event that earrings cannot be removed please ensure that you cover your child's earrings with tape or send in tape for your child to put over their own earrings. **Teachers are unable to apply the tape.** The children will go outdoors for PE and you will be informed of this through your child's homework diary. It may be that jogging trousers/leggings and a jacket/hoody are required.

School Uniform

The boys and girls are all looking very smart in their school uniform, thank you for your support in this. Please note our school uniform **is blue trousers/skirt/pinafore, blue polo shirt or shirt and tie and a blue jumper or cardigan**. Please ensure your child brings a jacket to school each day, as you know our weather can be very changeable and we try to go outdoors daily.
