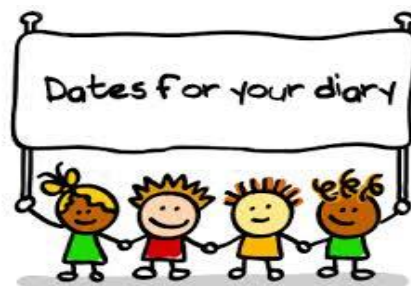

Parent Pay



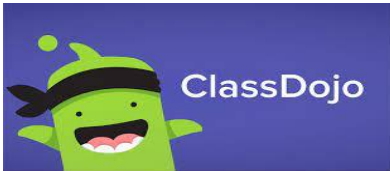

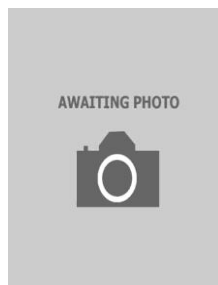
