Dear Parents,

Thank you for your continued efforts at drop off and pick up times. Children are now very accustomed to the new Covid safe learning environment & are becoming much more proficient in washing hands & settling into class in the mornings.

**We will be making a few changes after the October week holiday, from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October,**

We would ask that **from this date** Primary 1 parents leave their child at the school gate every morning and do not enter the playground. Parents can enter the playground at the end of the day, 2.45pm, to collect Primary 1 children. We would ask that parents leave the playground promptly to allow the rest of the school to leave safely.

After the October week holiday, **from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October**, we are also going to tighten up the times for entry and dismissal. This will ensure less waiting time for pupils and parents as the cold & wet weather comes in. Arrangements will be:

Rooms 1,2,3,14,15 - 8.45am – 2.45pm

Rooms 4,5,6,7,12,13 – 8.55am – 2.55pm

Rooms 8,9,10,11 – 9am – 3pm

Arrangements with siblings can remain the same, siblings can come in to school and get picked up at the earlier time.

We would ask parents to leave the area around the gate as soon as they have collected their child, as it will be slightly more congested. We would ask that parents arrive on time to pick up children, as children cannot re enter the school after dismissal time. The gazebo will continue to be used as a pick up point.

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### SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

We have arranged for a photographer to come into the school and nursery to take individual photos of the children. The company is called Monument Photos and they can take indoor and outdoor photos using a gazebo for shelter. Photographs will be taken on Tues 20<sup>th</sup>, Wed 21<sup>st</sup> and Fri 23<sup>rd</sup> if extra day required. Packs of photos vary in price from £13.50 to £32. Every child will get an individual photo taken and parents will receive the proofs. Parents will be under no obligation to purchase photos. Follow link to view Covid certification.
