Just as a guide to try and get a good mix of hamper goodies together, here's a suggested list to pick from (we're not expecting every item!)

P1 -Mince Pies / Christmas Cake / Christmas Pud / Wine & beer etc

P2 - Crackers / Oatckakes / Chutneys / Breadsticks / Wine etc

P3 -Truffles / Mints / Fudge / Tablet / Wine & beer etc

P4 -Crisps / Snacks / Jars of Olives/Pickles etc / Wine & beer etc

P5 - Chocolate / Fancy Sweets / Jams / Wine & beer etc

P6 - Teas / Coffees / Hot Chocolate / Wine & beer etc

P7 - Shortbread / Biscuits / Tea Cakes / Small Panettone/ Wine etc
