We have had an update from Bishop John regarding the Sacraments. The Church are hoping to celebrate the Sacraments of First Holy Communion at P4 stage and Confirmation at the P7 stage before the summer holidays. Confirmations will be celebrated in parish churches again, if allowed, depending on restrictions. The Sacrament of First Reconciliation may have to be celebrated in schools, if permitted with restrictions. The Bishop will make videos presentations with a Rite of Enrolment for each Sacrament for families to follow from home. As restrictions come and go, we will work closely with the church on any revisions necessary to our plans. This is diocesan policy as it currently stands. Pauline Kelly will be working with Fr Jim to make plans and we will keep parents updated.
