Dear Parents/ Carers,

SCHOOLS UPDATE

All nursery and P1-3 children returned to school on Monday 22nd February 2021, with home learning continuing for our children in P4-7.

The First Minister was quite clear in her announcement that the return to school for Nursery, P1-3 did not signal a wider easing of restrictions and the '**stay at home**' message remains very much in place.

The return of the children will be monitored over the next few weeks to assess the impact on community transmission of the new more infectious variants. It is vital, as a school community, we do all in our power to minimise the opportunities for transmission and keep everyone associated with our school as safe as possible. In doing this we have the best chance to see our P4-7 children return soon (possible date 15th March).

As our Nursery & P1-3 children return the COVID-19 mitigations that were in place before we broke up in December will continue. Including:

- Strict social distancing for adults
- Only one adult per family accompanies/collects our children.
- Adults are still required to wear a face-covering at the school gates & inside the school grounds.

All parents were sent a Parent Guide with more details. Please let the school know if you were not sent the link and we will check our contact details for you.

Nursery Applications for 2021/22

Nursery applications for August 2021 have now closed as of 28th February 2021. If you require further information or have not yet submitted an online application please contact the school office as soon as possible to ensure your child secures a place at your chosen Early Learning and Childcare Class. If your child currently attends St Charles' ELCC **you do not need to re – apply**, however, a preference sheet must be completed before the Admission panel which takes place in April.

Lochfield ELCC

We are delighted to announce that the new Lochfield ELCC is due to open after the Easter holidays. This will be an extended hours establishment and will be operational from 8am to 6pm, 52 weeks of the year, excluding public holidays.
