

Home Learning for P3 - P7 Pupils

In St. Charles' Primary School the home learning tasks have been designed to provide challenge for children but also allow them to make connections of their learning to real life contexts. We aim to offer parents and families fun ways to extend their child's learning opportunities beyond the classroom by:

- Providing additional practice of skills learned at school
- Informing parents of what is being taught
- Encouraging family learning opportunities

In P3 -P7 classes Home Learning tasks are provided in the format of a learning grid. A new home learning grid will be issued monthly on **SeeSaw** and will be varied, meaningful and interesting.

Children will be involved in class discussion and be given verbal feedback throughout the week by the class teacher. Exemplars of completed homework tasks will be shared. Children should be prepared to share, present or discuss their home learning tasks each week to the rest of the class.

All children will be issued with a Home Learning jotter to record their work. This jotter should be returned to school on a Friday to allow children to share what they have recorded.

The Home Learning grid will provide children with tasks linked to the following: -

- Spelling tasks
- Reading related tasks
- Grammar related activities
- Numeracy tasks (written or oral)
- Opportunities for mental maths challenges
- Mathematics tasks (written or oral)
- ICT tasks
- Family learning activities

Children should also continue to practise their times tables regularly. Children should also continue to regularly read a book for enjoyment.

Additional home learning tasks related to Religious Education, Topic, Health & Well-being tasks and solo talks will be provided throughout the year, where appropriate.
