TOYS & PERSONAL ITEMS IN SCHOOL

An increasing number of children are bringing toys and items from home into school on a Friday for Fun 31 Time. Parents/carers of all pre-school children attending our ELCC should have already received a leaflet explaining how to register for school August 2025. If any parent has not received this, please ask at the school office. Registration will be online through the Renfrewshire council website from 1st to 8th November 2024. Please find link below.

Apply for a place at school - Renfrewshire Website

When you are applying for a school place, you must provide:

- · evidence of your child's age
- proof that your family live in the catchment area of the school.

You will need to provide:

your child's full birth certificate

- your most recent Council Tax notice
- a Child Benefit Statement
- a Roman Catholic baptismal certificate, if required.

If you don't have a Child Benefit Statement, you'll need to provide us with one of the following:

- driving licence
- bank statement
- a utility bill, such as a gas or electricity bill, dated within the last 3 months that shows your current address.
- a court order, Looked After Child or foster carer documents.

Renfrewshire Council may ask you for more evidence if more proof of where you live is needed. You must provide original documents if they are requested.
