

In St. Charles' Primary School the home learning tasks have been designed to provide challenge for children but also allow them to make connections of their learning to real life contexts. We aim to offer parents and families fun ways to extend their child's learning opportunities beyond the classroom by:

- · Providing additional practice of skills learned at school
- Informing parents of what is being taught
- · Encouraging family learning opportunities

In Primary 4-7, home learning tasks are shared weekly on Microsoft Teams. All children will be issued with a Home Learning Jotter to record learning for submission on a Friday morning.

Home Learning tasks will provide children with a variety of -

- spelling tasks
- reading related tasks
- Big Cat eBooks
- numeracy tasks (written or oral)
- ICT tasks
- · Religious tasks
- and/or family learning activities

Children should continue to practise their times tables regularly and read a book for enjoyment daily.
