

In St. Charles' Primary School the home learning tasks have been designed to provide challenge for children but also allow them to make connections of their learning to real life contexts. We aim to offer parents and families fun ways to extend their child's learning opportunities beyond the classroom by:

- Providing additional practice of skills learned at school
- Informing parents of what is being taught
- · Encouraging family learning opportunities

In Primary 2 and 3, home learning tasks are presented in a learning grid issued weekly on Seesaw. We hope that this allows families maximum flexibility for children completing the tasks. Completed work should be submitted in the Home Learning jotter provided and submitted to school on a **Friday morning**.

Home Learning tasks will provide children with a variety of -

- phonics/spelling tasks
- Big Cat eBooks
- Reading related tasks
- Numeracy tasks (written or oral)
- Opportunities for mental maths challenges
- Mathematics tasks (written or oral)
- ICT tasks
- Family learning activities

There will also be Religious Education tasks.

Children should continue to practise their number bonds regularly and read a book for enjoyment every day.
