INVITATIONS TO SHARE YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING

Thank you to all the Parents & extended family members who have attended our "Best Seat in the House" assemblies and "Open Doors" afternoons so far this year. There are several others planned for this school session. The next "Best Seat in the House" assembly for P6 parents is on Thursday 27th November at 9.15am.

The children have really enjoyed sharing some of their learning with friends & family. Remember Open Doors is very informal, and parents do not need to attend for the full-time allocation. It is fine to come along and stay for just a little while.

"Storytime by Fairy light" is a parent/child activity we introduced a few years ago for P2 children & it was so well received by participants we now host it annually. The sessions promote books & a love of storytelling. We plan to host two sessions early in the new year. More information and a sign-up form will be issued to P2 parents. Spaces are limited & will be offered on a first-come basis.

I respectfully ask that parents do not arrive before scheduled times for any events as we have no waiting area if the weather is inclement.

LUNCH DEBT

I would ask all parents to ensure children always have adequate funds available on Parent Pay to cover the cost of school lunches. While all children P1-P5 are entitled to a free school lunch, a number of children in P6 & P7 are regularly presenting for a school lunch with no means to pay. The school is required to issue debt letters each week until any outstanding balance is paid. Please speak to Mrs Hannigan if you are experiencing difficulty in providing your child with a midday meal.

PARENTS' EVENINGS

Parent/teacher interviews will be held in the school on Weds 12th November 5.30pm-8.30pm and on Thursday 13th November 3.30pm-6.30pm. Appointments are now available to book on Parent Portal. You should have received a text yesterday to advise the booking system has gone live. Booking system closes on 11th November & appointments can be changed or cancelled up until 3pm on that date.

Please remember you need to book an appointment for each child. (2 children = 2 appointment times) If you have any difficulties in booking a suitable appointment, please contact the school office for assistance.

As always, all senior staff are available on the evening on a drop-in basis.

Any child (P1, P4 & P7) who works with Mrs MacLean will be issued with a letter to advise when she is available. The tear off slip should be returned to Mrs MacLean to book the slot.

REGISTRATION OF NEW ENTRANTS (PRIMARY ONE) FOR AUGUST 2026

If your child's fifth birthday is between 1 March 2026 and 28 February 2027, you should register them for school this November.

Registration takes place between Monday 3 and Friday 7 November 2025.

If you, or someone you're helping, can't register online, you can contact your local primary school and make an appointment to register in person during the registration dates.

To register your child to go to another school outside of your catchment area, you'll need to register them at a school within your catchment area first, then make a placing request.

If you can't register your child for school till after Friday 7 November, please contact your local primary school directly.

Children who will be 4 when school starts in August 2026 can apply to be deferred and get an additional year of free nursery and childcare. Please talk to your child's nursery or childminder.

Apply for school on Renfrewshire Council's website.

During the registration process, you will be required to produce the following documentation to support your child's entry to school:

- 1. Child's full Birth Certificate
- 2. Most recent Council Tax Notice or if not currently resident in the property either a concluded missive or a signed and witnessed tenancy agreement/lease.

- 3. Child Benefit Statement. (In the event that a Child Benefit Statement is not available, a Driving Licence or a Bank Statement/utility bill showing transactions over the most recent 3 months and the applicant's address may be accepted). Or if appropriate to current circumstances: Court Order / Looked After Child/Foster carer document(s).
- 4. Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate if your child has been baptised.

You should be able to access further information by searching 'apply for a place at school' on Renfrewshire Council website.

We look forward to welcoming many new children & families to our school community next session.

PROMOTING RACIAL LITERACY & INCLUSION

As part of our commitment to fostering a welcoming and respectful school environment for all, we are excited to introduce a new regular feature in our school bulletin: Promoting Racial Literacy and Inclusion. From January to June, this section will highlight how we are helping children understand and appreciate diversity, challenge stereotypes, and build empathy and respect for all cultures and backgrounds as well as recognising the important contributions people with disabilities make in society. Primary 5 children will be leading on this work. Both P5 classes recently spent an afternoon with a motivational speaker, Bart Gee, learning all about "Turning Disabilities into Possibilities". P5 parents joined their children at the end of the day to share in their learning. Watch this space for more information on what we are doing in school & how you can promote this learning at home.

HEALTHY SNACKS

Lots of our children bring healthy snacks to school each day. If you provide a snack, please encourage your child to choose fruit or crisps as an alternative to chocolate or hard, chewy sweets. Water can be consumed throughout the day and while it is best for children to avoid drinking juice, if they must have it, this should only be consumed with lunch. Lollipops are not safe to consume in a busy playground and children are frequently reminded these should not be eaten in school. The Pupil Leadership Group have revised the shopping list for Golden Ticket Tea Parties. The list now consists of much healthier options such as, fresh fruit kebabs, watermelon slices, lemon water, bread sticks & cream cheese. This is a much healthier selection than before. There is still a small number of sugary snacks available such as chocolate buttons & chocolate dipping sauce, but these are limited to one portion. House captains conducted an evaluation & it was an overwhelming success with those who had attended.
