Dear Parents,

Happy 2026 and welcome back to everyone! It has been wonderful to see our pupils return to school so settled and ready to learn. We would also like to sincerely thank parents and carers for the continued support with school uniform. Your support is greatly appreciated as we begin another busy and exciting year together.

We are very much looking forward to welcoming the HMIE Inspectors to St Charles Primary School next week, when they will be spending a full week with us. We are excited to share the high-quality learning that takes place in our school and, most importantly, to showcase our wonderful children who demonstrate our school values of kindness, honesty and determination every day. We are proud of our whole school community and look forward to this opportunity to celebrate all that we do together.

We would warmly welcome any new parent helpers who may be interested in volunteering in the school, especially if you have a skill or interest you would like to share with our pupils. All volunteers are required to have a PVG check in place, and as this process can take some time to complete, we encourage anyone interested to let us know as soon as possible. We already have a small number of volunteers, and their support makes a valuable difference to children's learning in school.

MOBILE PHONES & SMART WATCHES IN SCHOOL

If your child has received a new mobile phone or smart watch for Christmas and you feel it is necessary for this item to be brought to school, it is essential that your child follows school guidelines. Phones must be switched off when children enter the school gate in the morning and remain in their own schoolbag during the day. These can only be removed to be used when the pupil leaves the school grounds. If your child wears a Smart Watch this should not be used to make calls or send text messages during the school day. If any child is found to be using their device during the school day or on school premises, then parents will be contacted & asked to collect the phone or watch. Children should not take photographs or make recordings at any time in school on personal devices. This guidance is in place to safeguard all children and protect them from potential harm. Please note it is also applicable when children are travelling on the school bus.

Please note that the school is not responsible for any phones that are lost or damaged on school property. It would be preferable for these expensive personal items not to be brought to school.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE & REPORTING PUPIL ABSENCE

As we start a new year, I thought it may be helpful at to re- issue this information.

If your child is unwell and cannot attend school, please phone the school office or email stcharlesenquiries@renfrewshire.gov.uk by 9.30 am on the first day of absence. If no telephone call or email is received, parents will automatically receive a text message asking them to phone the school as a matter of urgency. If an absence is planned, please inform the head teacher in writing.

Attendance alert letters are issued to parents automatically if pupil attendance falls below 90% no matter the reason for this. Unfortunately, a significant number of families have received an attendance alert letter since August some of these resulting from family holidays being taken during term time. I would ask that you take school dates into consideration when planning family holidays as this will help to avoid your child missing learning.

In St Charles' if a child requires to depart early for any reason the school office should be contacted in advance to arrange collection. Parents will be asked to provide a reason for early collection, and this should only happen in exceptional circumstances. If your child is regularly late for school or collected early this time away from learning can accumulate very quickly.

Please note- No child will be permitted to leave early unless collected by an authorised adult.

This year we will be placing a strong focus on improving school attendance across our school community. Regular attendance is vital to children's learning, helping them to build knowledge, develop friendships, and feel confident and secure in school routines. When children attend school every day, they have the best possible opportunity to achieve their full potential. We appreciate the continued support of parents and carers in ensuring children attend regularly and arrive on time, working together we can give all our children the very best start.

HEALTH & WELLBEING

We are currently busy planning our annual Health Week, which will take place during the week beginning 26 January. This is always a fantastic opportunity for pupils to learn more about keeping healthy in fun and engaging ways. More information about planned activities and events will be shared with families soon, so please keep an eye out for further updates.

It is always really helpful if parents discuss lunch options with children prior to each school day. Meals are ordered before 9.30am each day to allow our kitchen staff time to prepare and cook the lunches. Water and fruit are on offer every day for all children who attend the lunch hall. Parents are asked to provide a healthy snack for mid-morning break such as fruit or cereal bar. All children are encouraged to drink only water during the day as they work in class. Parents are asked to provide their child with a water bottle (NOT GLASS) for this purpose. This should be clearly marked with your child's name and taken home at the end of each day to be cleaned & refilled before being brought back to school the next morning. If you allow your child to drink fruit juice, this may be taken as part of his/her lunch but may not be consumed during lessons in class. Please note fizzy drinks are not permitted in school at any time.

The next planned meeting of this session will be held in the school on Wednesday 21st January 2026 @ 6.30pm. **All** parents/carers are welcome to attend Parent Hub meetings so please come along if you can.
