Dear Parents,

We are absolutely delighted to be able to welcome our Primary 4-7 pupils back to school on Monday 15th March 2021. Please be assured that the safety, health & well-being of our children, staff, & families will be our primary focus as we recognise the challenges faced by many during the period of school closure.

Staggered start & dismissal times are necessary to minimise congestion & maximise pupil safety, we will revert to core operational hours of 9am – 3pm when we are safely able to do so.

P4/5 pupils will start the day at 9.00am and be dismissed at 3.00pm

P1 pupils will start the day at 9.05am and be dismissed at 3.05pm

P6/7 pupils will start the day at 9.05am and be dismissed at 3.05pm

P3/4 pupils will start the day at 9.10am and be dismissed at 3.10pm

P2 pupils will start the day at 9.15am and be dismissed at 3.15pm

Please see map for designated area for each class. Please do not wait in any other area – pupils will be collected and dismissed at these points. We appreciate your co-operation in keeping the Pupil Entrance area clear at all times.



If you are running late, SLT will remain at the pupil entrance until 9.20m each day – no admittance via the main entrance is permitted.

At the beginning and end of each day we ask for your co-operation to arrive promptly at your child's start time. Please do not arrive early – we must work together to minimise the number of adults in the school grounds at any time.

Also at the end of the day, we ask that you arrive promptly for your child's dismissal time and exit the playground area immediately after collection.

All adults should wear face coverings, unless exempt, and should maintain 2m social distancing from other adults from other households at all times. We kindly ask that wherever possible, only one adult is present to at drop off/collection times.

At the beginning and end of the school day, we urge you **not to use the Trim Trail** – pupils have access to this equipment throughout the school day and this is managed in line with our health and safety risk assessments.

If you need to speak to a member of staff, even briefly, we ask that you do not approach them outside and rather contact the school via Seesaw, email or phone when we will be happy to discuss anything with you.

P.E will continue to be outdoors and we ask you to consider what your child is wearing - children will also be outside at breaktimes and for outdoor learning experiences. Our relaxed uniform remains in place.
