

KEEP KIDS SAFE APP

The Keep Kids Safe App will launch on 22nd November. Here is some information about the App.

The Keep Safe Kids app is a new and easier way for children and young people to access health and wellbeing information and support as well as to report bullying directly to their school.

Pupils can open the app and make reports at any time of day or night as well as make anonymous reports, helping them to control when and how they tell someone about an incident or their concerns.

Reports are sent directly to that child or young person's school to be picked up in line with the school's antibullying and wellbeing policies. Reports are not held on the app or accessible to anyone else, ensuring confidentiality and reports will not be picked up outside standard school hours.

 Followed by breakfast in the hall.
- P4 May Procession St Margaret's Church at 12 o'clock. Communion clothes can be worn.
 Children attend church with family.

- P7 Sacrament of Confirmation St Margaret's Church at 7pm Tuesday 31st May
- Feast of corpus Christi P4 and P7 pupils lead procession at St Margaret's Church 12 o'clock Sunday 19th June. Children attend church with family.
