Transition Programme and Induction Meeting

Below you will find the dates of the Transition Programme we can offer your children this year. Mrs Rowley will oversee this along with your child's nursery.

Date	Activity
11 th May	Teams Meet (9.30-10 am) – introduction to the Primary 1 classroom and Class Teacher with a shared story about starting school.
18 th May	Teams Meet (1.30-2.15pm) – Spanish with Primary 1. Learning some Spanish vocabulary and creating a collage Spanish Flag. The children will have some time to create their collage and share with each other online.
25 th May	Teams Meet (9.30-10.15am) – Music and Movement with Primary 1. The children will learn about keeping the beat and will make or find an instrument to make some music.
1 st June	Teams Meet (1.30-2.15pm) – A day in the life of Primary 1. The children will watch a video of Primary 1 as they go about their day in Primary 1 allowing the children to see around the school and meet other members of staff.
7 th June	Teams Induction Meet for Parents (10.30-12pm) - Meet the Senior Leadership Team and Primary 1 Teacher. School information provided and the opportunity to ask questions.
14 th June	Child and parent visits to the school begin this week to meet their Class Teacher face to face. (3.15-3.45pm) You will be contacted and provided with a given day to visit.

Arrival on First Day

***Please note the below information may change as per Government Guidance.
Currently we are unable to have parents inside the school building.***

Children will stay in school from 9:15am until 2:15pm for the first day thereafter it will be 9am- 3pm. On the first morning parents should bring their child into the school building through the classroom door in the playground. Parents and family can accompany their child into the classroom and take photographs if they wish to do so.

After the first day children should line up at their classroom door in the playground where they will be collected by the Class Teacher. Parents, when visiting the school must always enter through the front entrance in line with school security procedures.

All children must be collected by an adult promptly at 3pm in the infant playground.

School Lunches/Clothing Grants

Children can bring a packed lunch or receive a school lunch. All children from Primary 1 -3 are eligible for a free school meal. However, we would still encourage all parents to apply for this and/or a clothing grant (if you are eligible) as this helps the school to receive grants and funding, please see the Renfrewshire Council's website for more details.

Parent Pay

ParentPay is a secure online payment system that has replaced cash payments in all Renfrewshire Schools. With ParentPay, parents and carers will be able to pay for their child's school meals, trips, events and activities online using a debit or credit card. Your child will require a picture to allow them to choose their lunch and all parents and carers will be required to set up an account for their child in August. More information will be provided on the induction meeting on 7th June.

Scottish Child Payment

Scottish Child Payment is a new benefit being introduced by the Scottish Government to tackle child poverty. It is for low income families already in receipt of qualifying benefits. To start with, Scottish Child Payment will be available to families with children under six years of age only. Scottish Child Payment will open for applications in November 2020, with first payments being made from the end of February 2021. Low-income families with a child under six will be able to apply for £10 per child, per week - equivalent to £520 per year. There are no limits on the number of eligible children supported by Scottish Child Payment. Nut, Kiwi and Mango Free Zone

We are a **Nut, Kiwi and Mango** free school due to children having severe allergies that are life threatening. Please always check the ingredients of your child's snacks prior to them bringing them into school.

Home Visits

At the beginning of your child's Primary 1, you will be offered a home visit, ***should COVID restrictions allow***. This will give you a chance to meet with your child's Teacher and Elizabeth Callery, our Inclusion Support Assistant. At this, parents are provided with information about their child's education and can ask questions about P.E. Homework, Playground etc.

Uniform

In St. Fergus' all pupils wear an agreed uniform, which is:

As all uniforms are identical it is very difficult to track down individual items of clothing which have been lost unless they are clearly marked with the child's name.

Absences

Please inform the school before 9.15am if your child is absent. If possible, all appointments for the dentist and doctor should be arranged out with school hours. Please make every effort to avoid family holidays during term time.

Wet Days

On wet mornings the children should be brought in through their classroom door which will be open from 8.50 am.

P.E. Days and Jewellery

You will be informed by the Class Teacher when your child is to have P.E. The children can leave shorts and sandshoes in the class. The children find it easier if they wear a polo shirt on P.E. days. For health and safety reasons we request that jewellery i.e. earrings, rings, bangles, necklaces are removed. Unfortunately, the school cannot replace valuable items of jewellery which are lost or stolen, therefore, to avoid distress children should not bring items of value to school.



Health Promoting School

As a health promoting school, we encourage children to bring a water bottle to school. Fizzy drinks and juice are not allowed.

Playground Supervision

There is an adult presence in the school playground at all times in St. Fergus. There are classroom assistants and an Inclusion Support Assistant on duty daily supported by the Janitor and Depute Head Teacher/Head Teacher when available. P7 children provide a buddying service to support P1 pupils in the first few weeks of their schooling.
