Class structures and staffing

I am pleased to report that Mrs J Degnan was appointed to a permanent position in our school. We wish her every success in her role here. At present we are working on the structure of our classes. It is likely that we will have composite classes at every stage next year.

European Referendum – School Closure

As you will be aware, the European Referendum will take place on Thursday 23 June. St Fillan's Primary School will be a Polling Station and therefore the school will be closed to pupils. Staff will be decanted to another establishment to work on that day.

Primary 1 intake

Our induction programme for our new Primary 1 entrants has now concluded. We will welcome our new boys and girls on Monday 15 August at 9.15am. There is a slightly later start on their first day. Thereafter, the children will come to school for 9am. They will be in school full time from their first day in August. Children should be brought to the drop off/collection zone at the end of the ramped entrance. Here they will be met by their class teacher Mrs McKay and escorted into school. Children should be collected from here by a parent/carer at the end of the school day at 3pm.

P7 residential trip

Our Primary 7 pupils had a great time on their residential trip to Lochgoilhead last month. The staff at the site commented on the excellent behaviour they demonstrated and their openness to the experiences offered. They were a credit to our school and to their families.

<u>STEM</u>

One of our pupils has been selected as one of the overall winners and we are delighted to congratulate Hannah in P5 for her winning invention. She will be attending a celebration at The Barony Hall Glasgow. A wonderful achievement.
