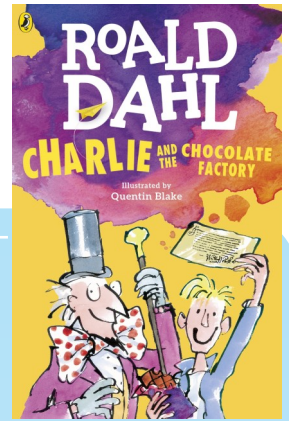
**Numeracy** In Numeracy, we have been working on Multiplication/Division, Fractions, Money, Time and Angles.
