Numeracy and Maths

This term we have been learning all about numbers to 10. We have been learning to count, order, match and write numbers through a variety of activities. We have been using different rhymes to help us with our number formation and are doing well remembering how to form each number correctly. We have also enjoyed exploring patterns and have been able to recognise and describe a variety of these. We worked enthusiastically using different objects and shapes to create some interesting patterns of our own. As part of Numeracy & Maths, we have also been learning to name and order the days of the week & months of the year, using songs & rhymes to help us.

Literacy

As part of Literacy this term, we have been learning our initial sounds using Jolly Phonics. We have enjoyed learning about each new sound and are doing well joining in with the songs and actions for each. We have been great 'sound detectives', identifying objects which begin with our sounds. We have also been working hard learning how to write each letter and have had fun practising using chalk, sand, paint and loose parts. For our 'Talk for Writing' we have been using the story of 'Pirate Tom' this term. We have really enjoyed learning the story and the actions to go with it. We have been great at using these to help us remember the important parts of the story. We have also created our very own story maps too!

Health and Wellbeing

To begin the term, we created our own Class Charter to help us develop our understanding of our class rules. We explored ways of how we can - 'Be Ready', 'Be Safe' and 'Be Respectful'. In P.E, our focus has been gymnastics this term. We have been developing a variety of skills including, how to make and hold shapes with our bodies and how to perform different rolls.

During our PATHS discussions, we have been learning about our different emotions and how to deal with these. As part of PATHS, we have loved being 'Star of the Day'. Each morning we sit down with our friends and share compliments with each other - a nice way to start our day in Primary 1!
