




Angel of God My Guardian dear, To whom God's love Commits us here. Ever this day, Be at my side. To light, to guard To rule and guide.

A Verbal Warning - Stop and have a think about your behaviour. Turn this around and make good choices.




Stop! Your behaviour is not showing you are 'Ready, Respectful or Safe.' This will mean some thinking time or a consequence.

Nurtured

Healthy

Having the highest attainable standards of physical and mental health, access to suitable healthcare, and support in learning to make healthy and safe choices.

Safe

Responsible cirizens Protected from abuse, neglect or harm at home, at school and in the community.

Active

Having opportunities to take part in activities such as play, recreation and sport which contribute to healthy growth and development, both at home and in the community.

Respected

Considerat individuals Having the opportunity, along with carers, to be heard and involved in decisions which affect them.

Responsible

Having opportunities and encouragement to play active and responsible roles in their schools and communities and, where necessary, having appropriate quidance and supervision and being involved in decisions that affect them.

GIRFEC

Having help to overcome social, educational, physical and economic inequalities and being accepted as part of the community in which they live and learn.


