The Class Teacher nominates one pupil, and the other children nominate the second winner. Reasons are provided and are shared with pupils after their visit to the Tea Party.

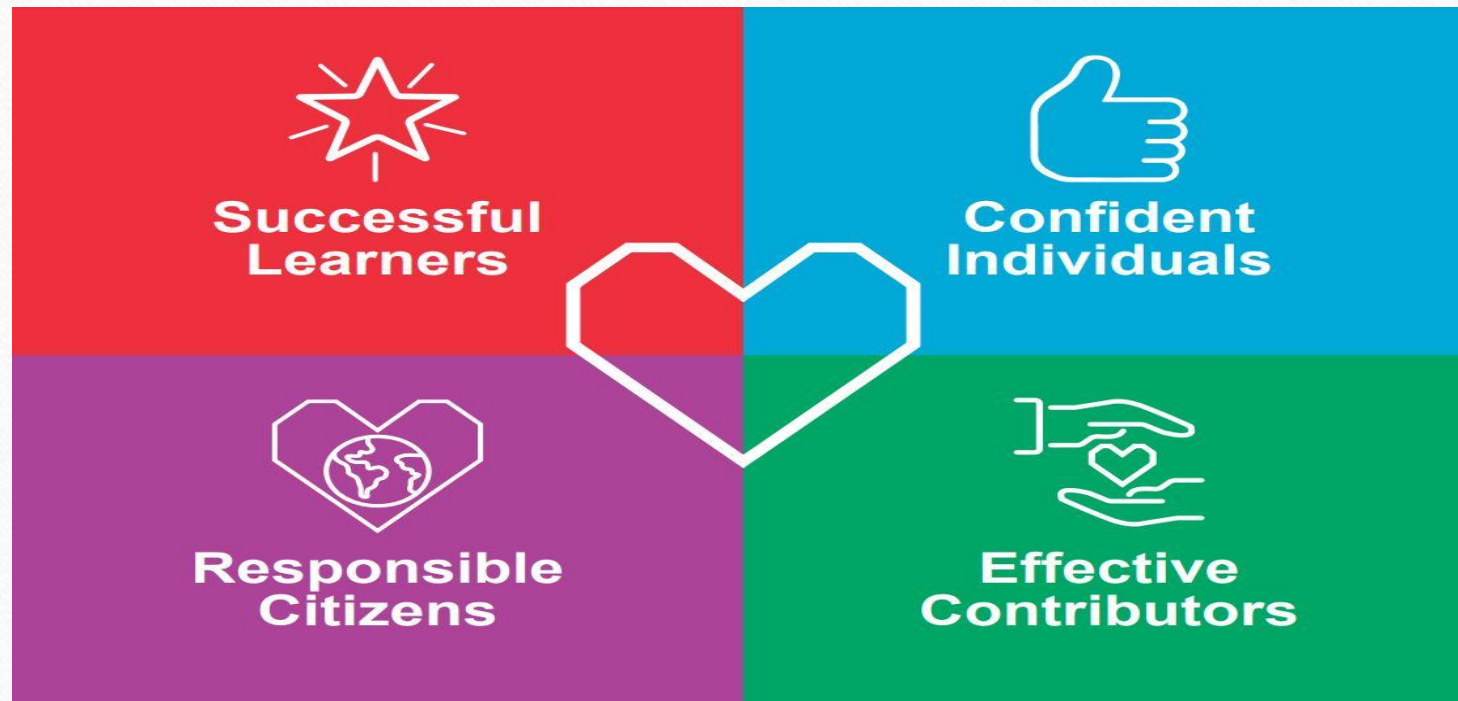

This strategy helps to build positive relationships between children at different stages and with the SLT.

Our children are comfortable and show resilience in the knowledge that they will be invited to attend the 'Golden Ticket Tea Party' as some stage during their time in St. Fillan's. They understand that this may not always be possible within the period of an academic session due to class sizes or a variety of other reasons.

It is important to note that a child's attendance is also tracked by Class Teacher's and if a child is unable to attend the 'Golden Ticket Tea Party' for a variety of reasons, then they will be invited to join the next available tea party in due course.

This month the children have also went above and beyond developing skills for learning, life and work.

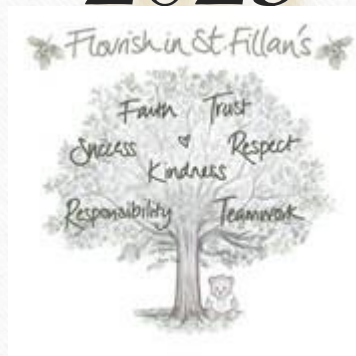
