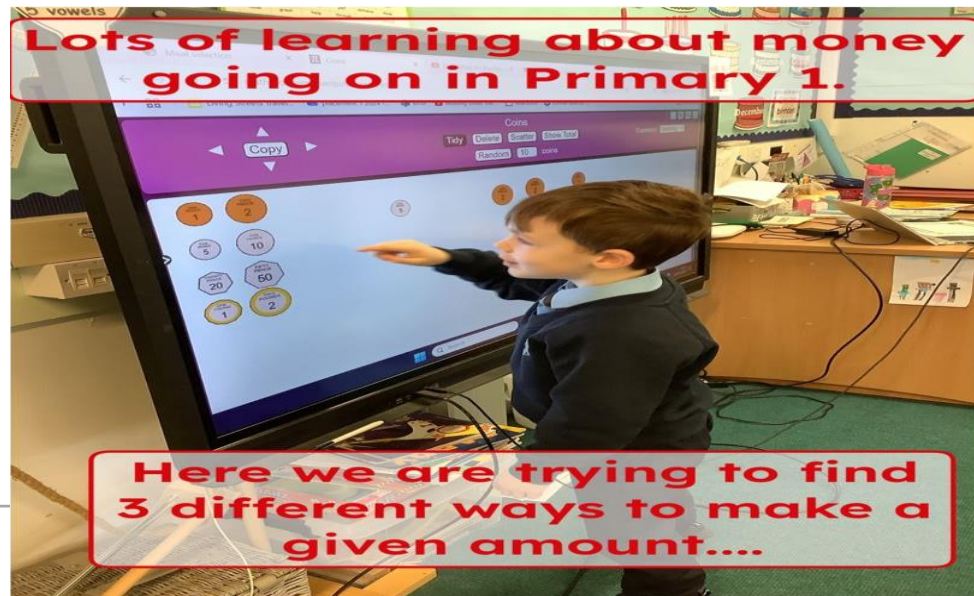

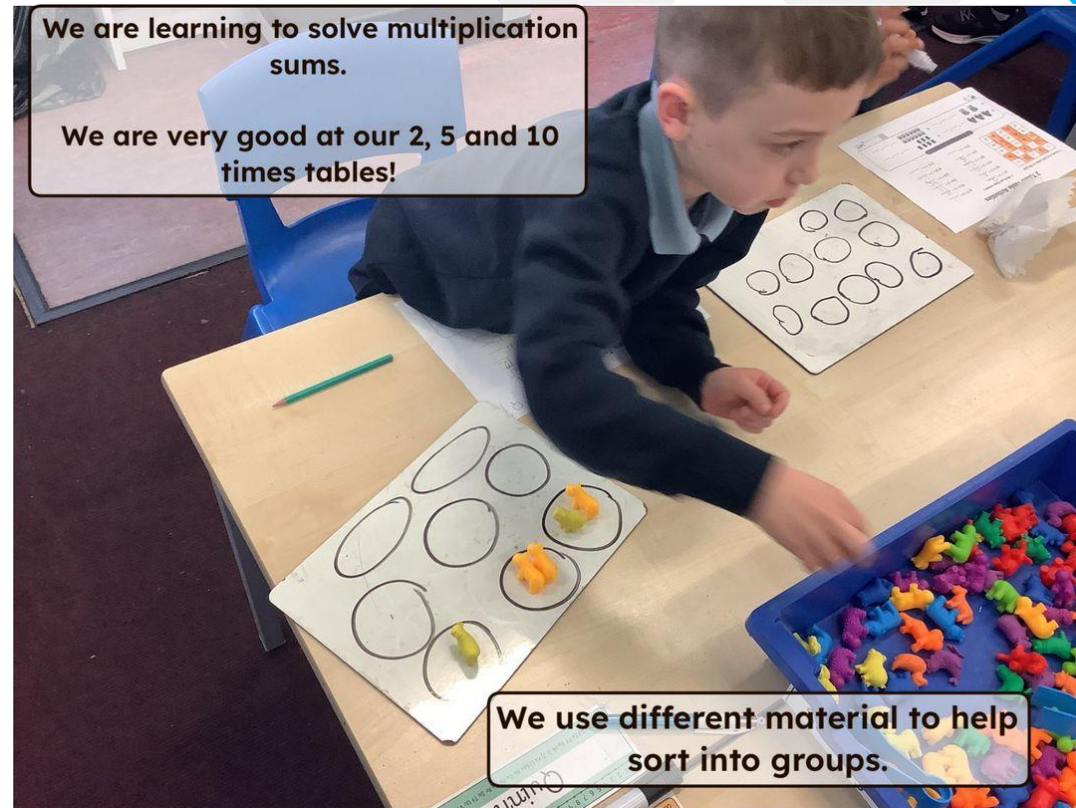


We had a great afternoon of PE doing lots of different stations.

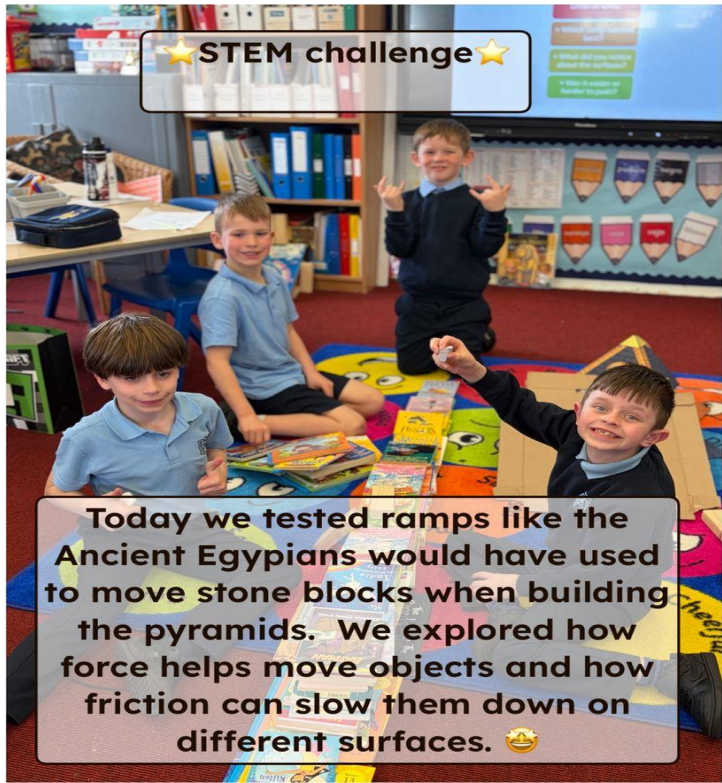

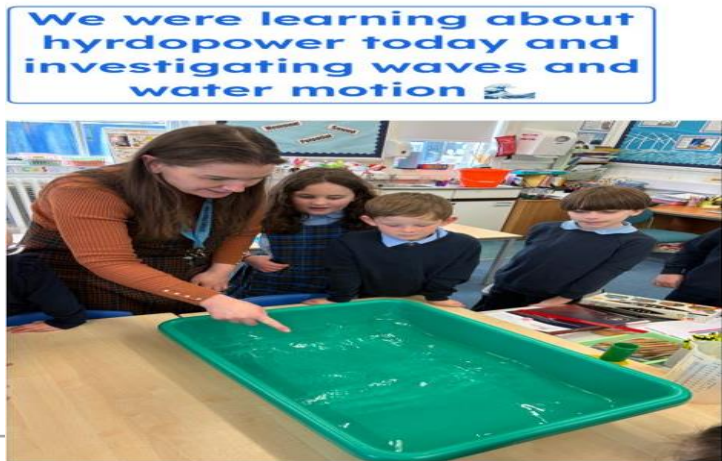

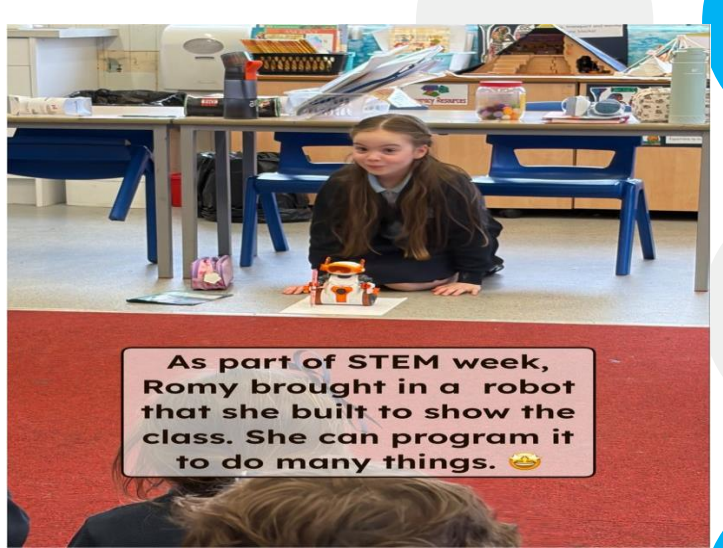

As part of STEM week, Romy brought in a robot that she built to show the class. She can program it to do many things. 🤖

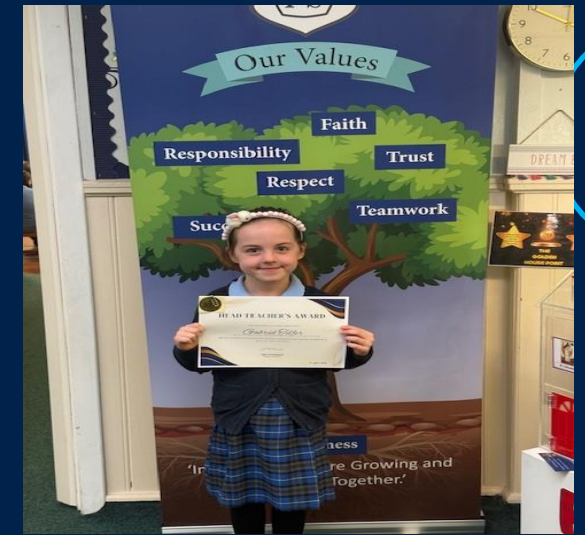
• ✨ Confident Individuals ✨

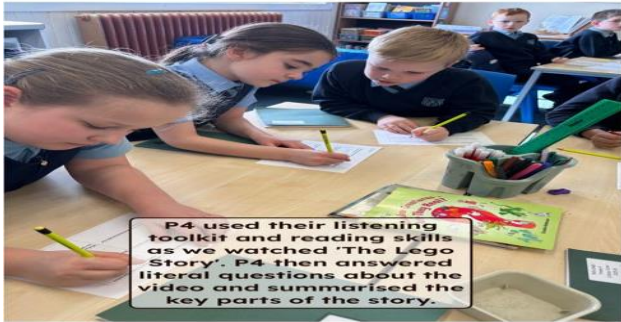
Easter egg hunt!



Easter STEM challenges: create a egg basket for a zip line and make a catapult to propel the chick across the room- lots of fun!

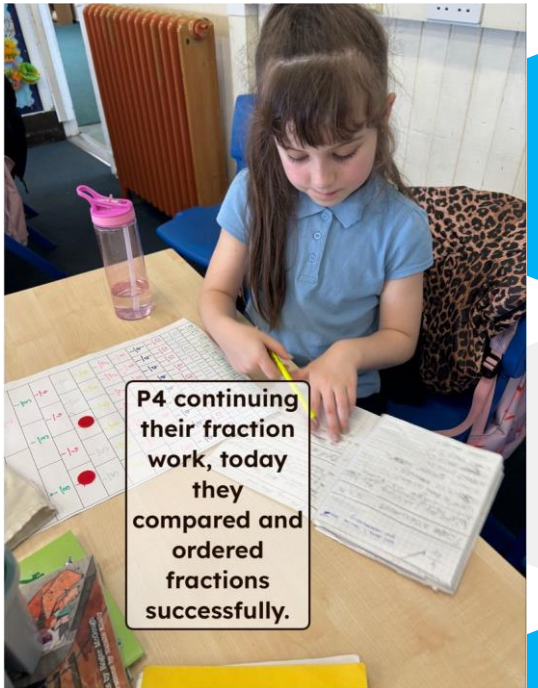
We have been developing our coding skills using block coding.

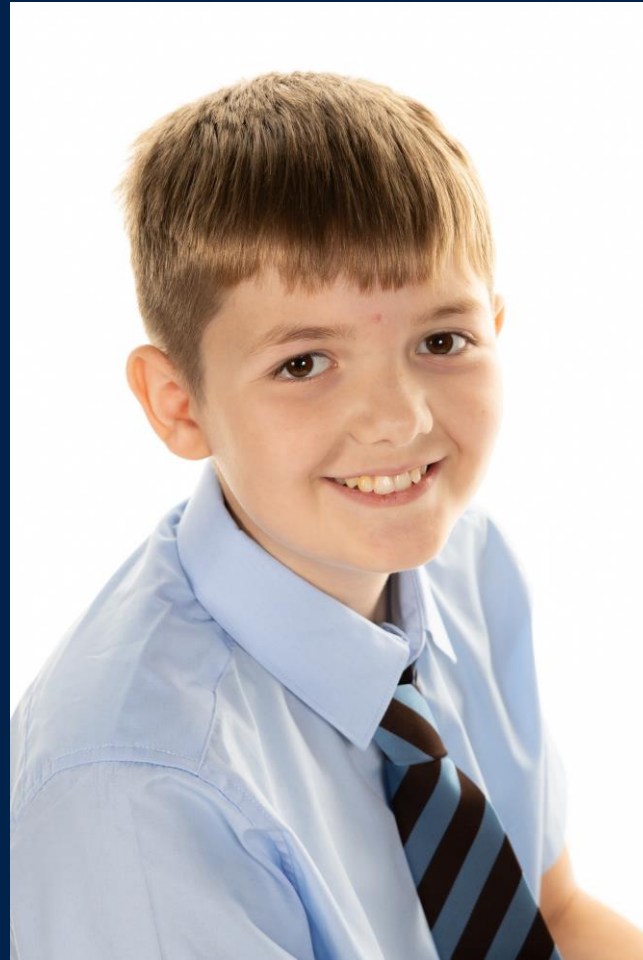

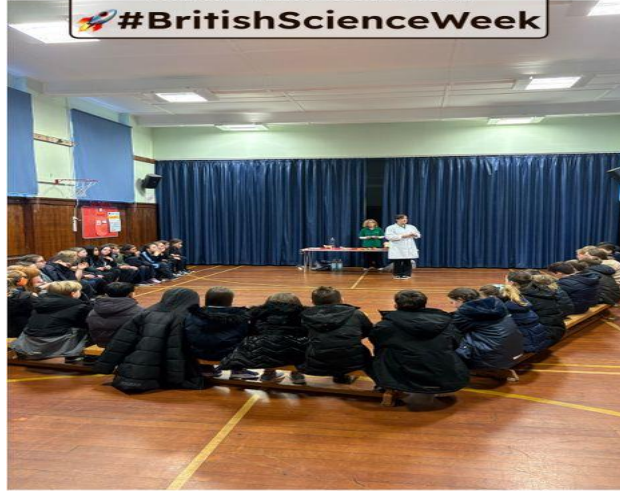

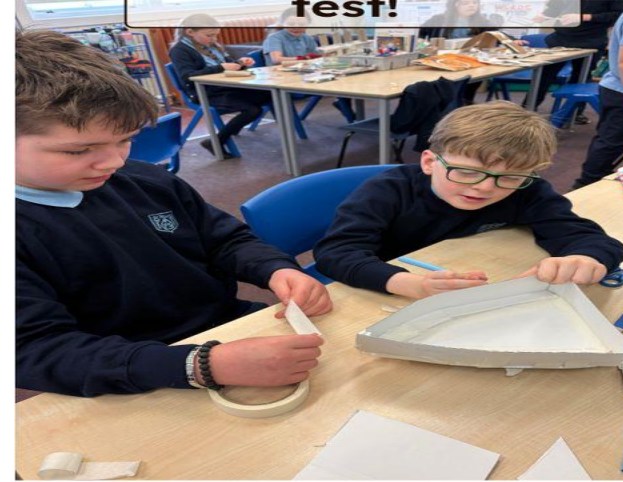
Mrs Lynagh gave a very interesting talk about genetics today!

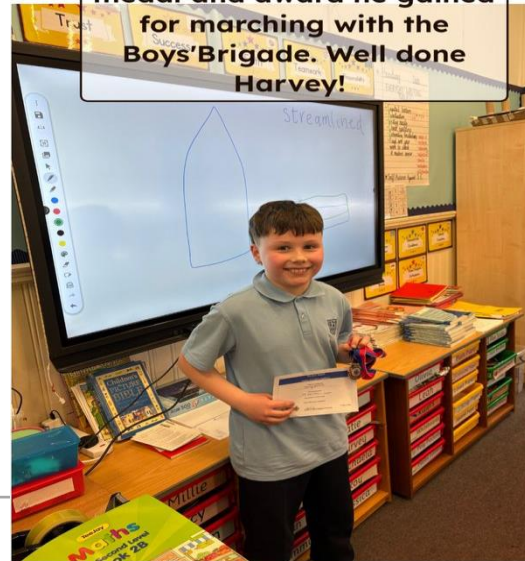
Our last session of Gaelic music today. Mrs McKay was very impressed at their singing! What do you think?

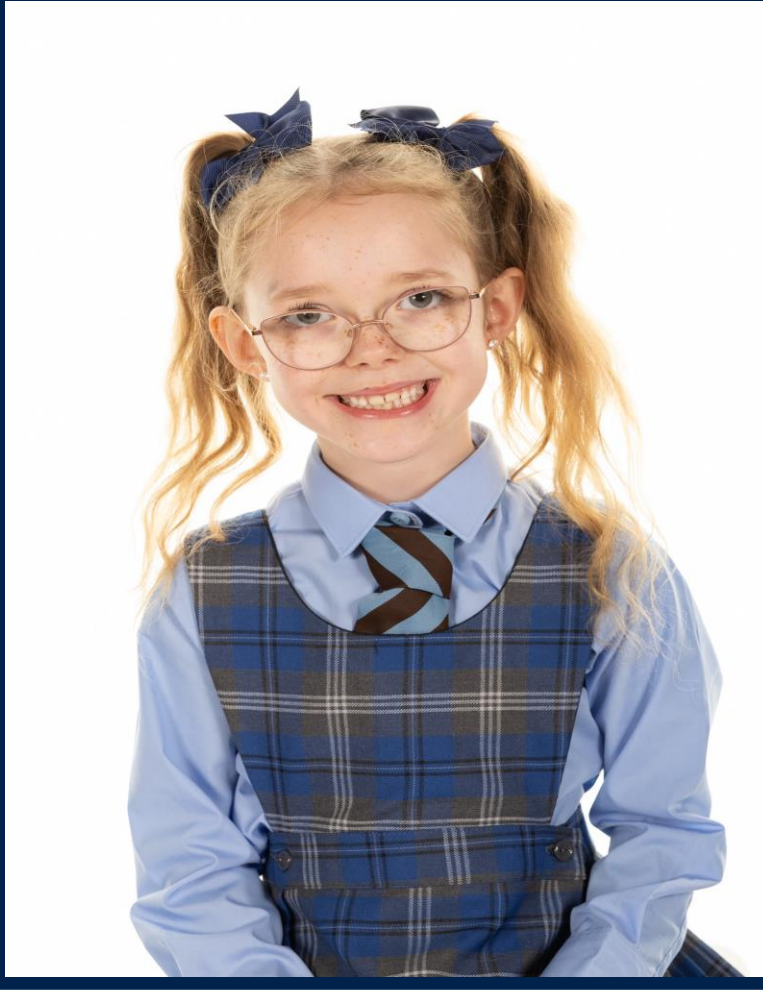

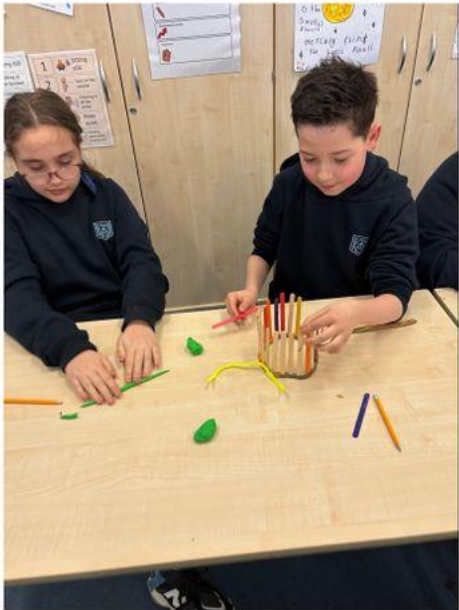

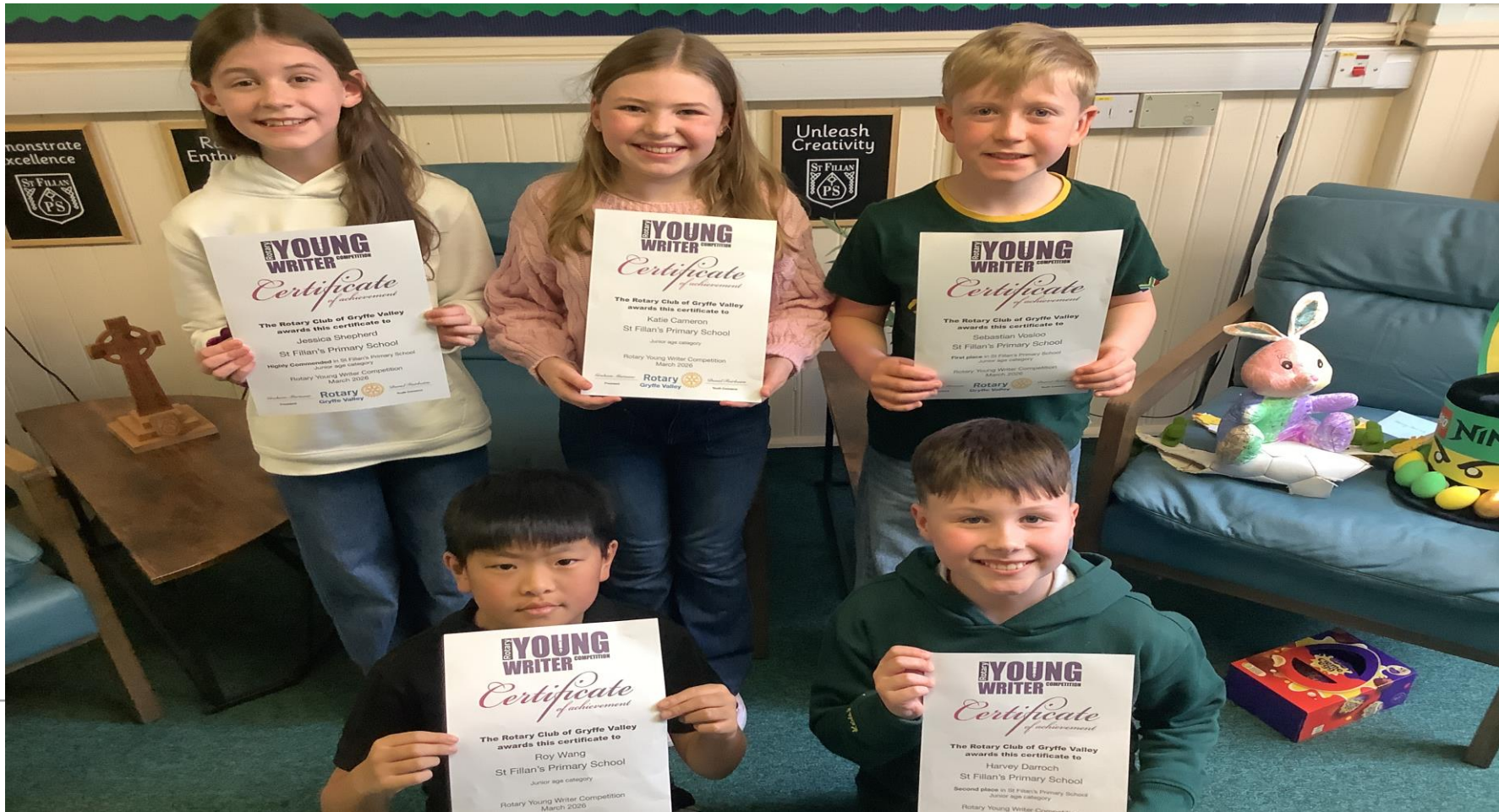








Our Rotary Club Writing Winners
