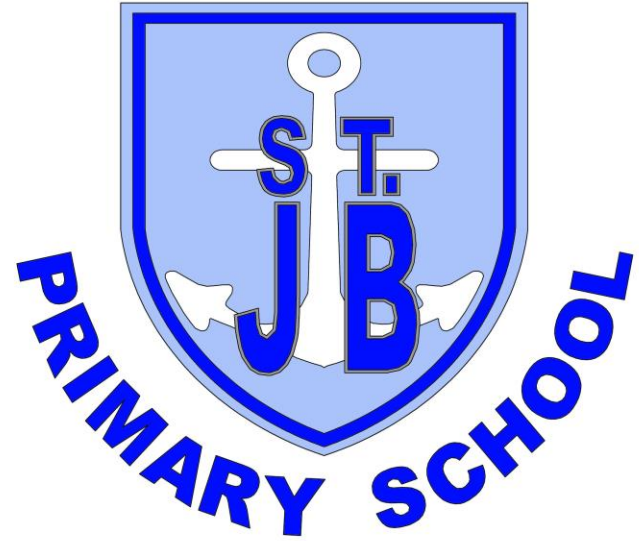

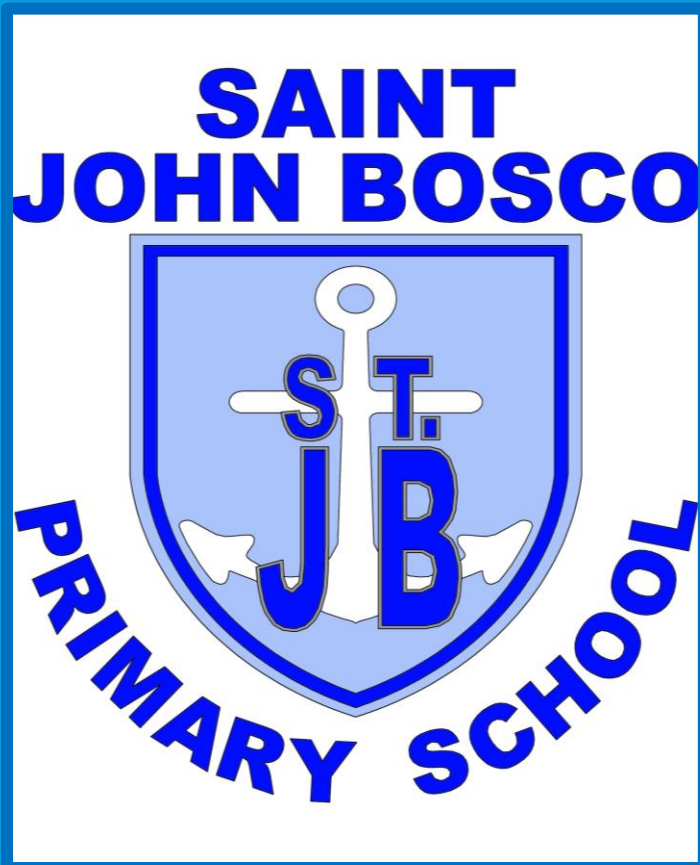

- Next session we will have a primary 1 and a primary 1/2 class. This has also been the case this session.



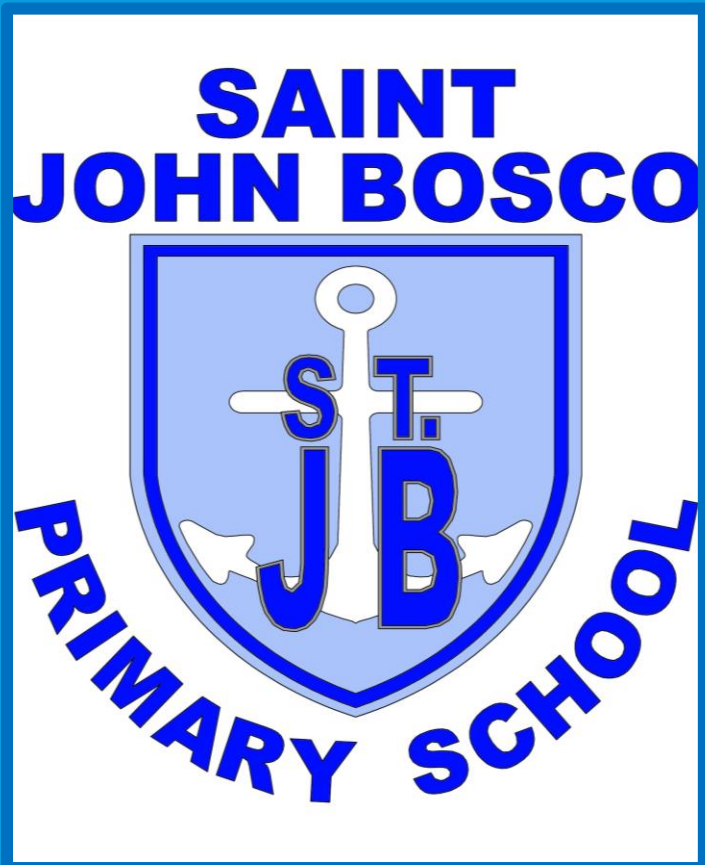
BUDDY SYSTEM



Your child has been allocated a pupil buddy.

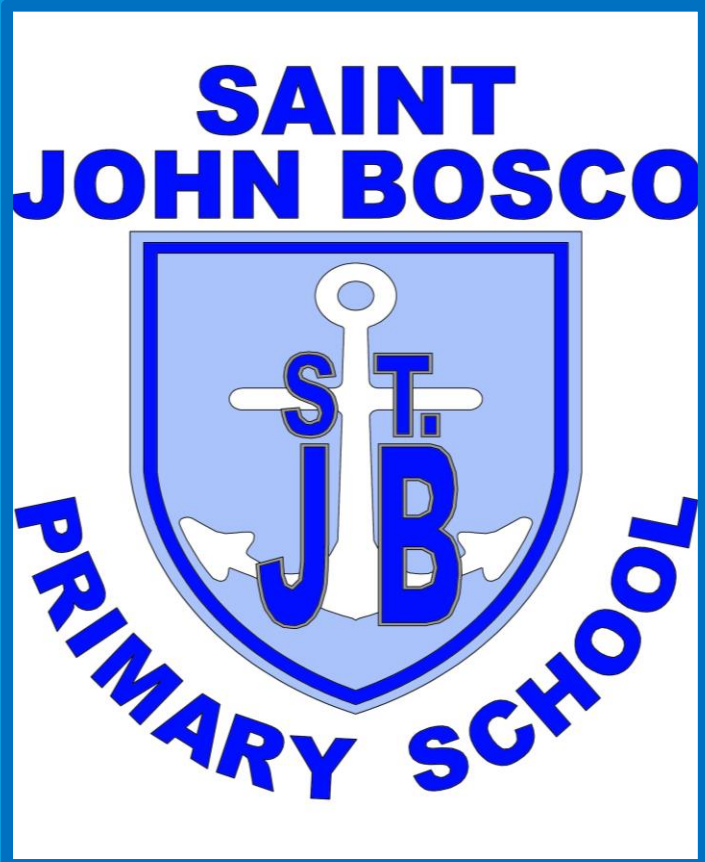
This child will be able to support your child in the playground and lunch hall as they settle into primary 1.

OUR SCHOOL UNIFORM - BOYS



Our school uniform

We are very proud of our school uniform in St John Bosco Primary School. Children should wear traditional school uniform every day. On PE days children get changed into PE kit.

Boys: Blue blazer/blue fleece jacket with school badge, grey trousers, blue shirt, school tie, grey pullover

Boys PE: Blue shorts, St John Bosco branded PE top, no jewellery. PE kits should be left in school. Children will change for PE lessons.

OUR SCHOOL UNIFORM - GIRLS



Our school uniform

We are very proud of our school uniform in St John Bosco Primary School. Children should wear traditional school uniform every day. On PE days children get changed into PE kit.

Girls: Blue blazer/blue fleece jacket with school badge, grey skirt / grey trousers, blue shirt, school tie, grey pullover/cardigan. **Please note tartan pinafores are not part of our school uniform.**

Girls PE: Blue shorts, St John Bosco branded PE top, no jewellery. PE kits should be left in school. Children will change for PE lessons.

FIRST DAY AT SCHOOL

TUESDAY 18TH AUGUST 2026



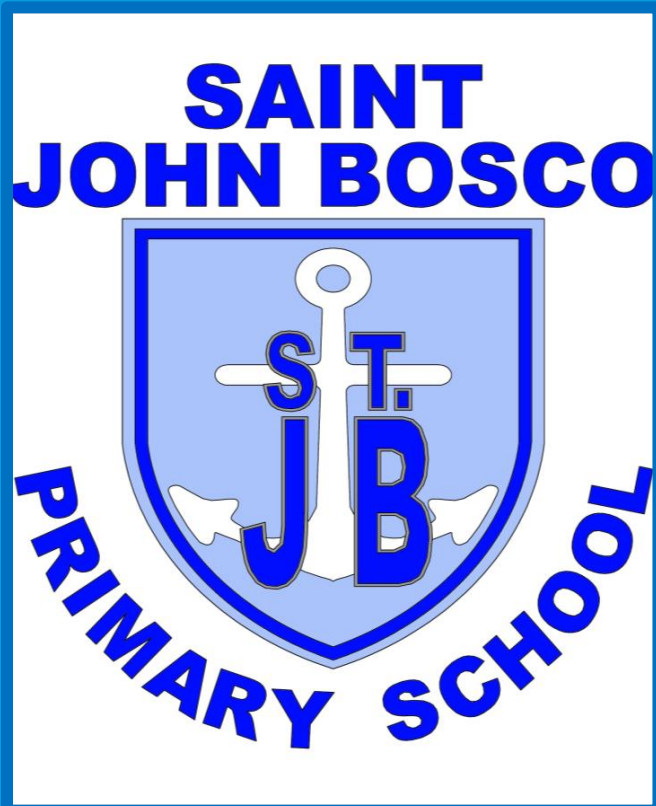
On this date we will welcome you and your child at 9.10am. Children and adults should enter the playground via the school gates next to the car park. You will be met by members of the senior leadership team and you will have the opportunity to take photographs of your child in the playground before they go into their classroom.

At 9.20am children will be directed to line up at their classroom door. Class teachers will take the children into the class to begin their first day at school.

Unless they are travelling home by school transport children should be collected from their classroom at the end of the school day.

Class teachers will dismiss children from the classroom at the end of the school day.

THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY



Your child's class teacher will not dismiss your child unless they know who is collecting them. Please ensure that you inform the class teacher if there is any change to collection arrangements.

If there is a change to your collection arrangements during the school day, please contact the school office.

If we are unsure over any collection arrangements, we will phone you to confirm these.

For children travelling by school transport please ensure that you inform the school of which days your child will be travelling by school transport.

BREAK TIME

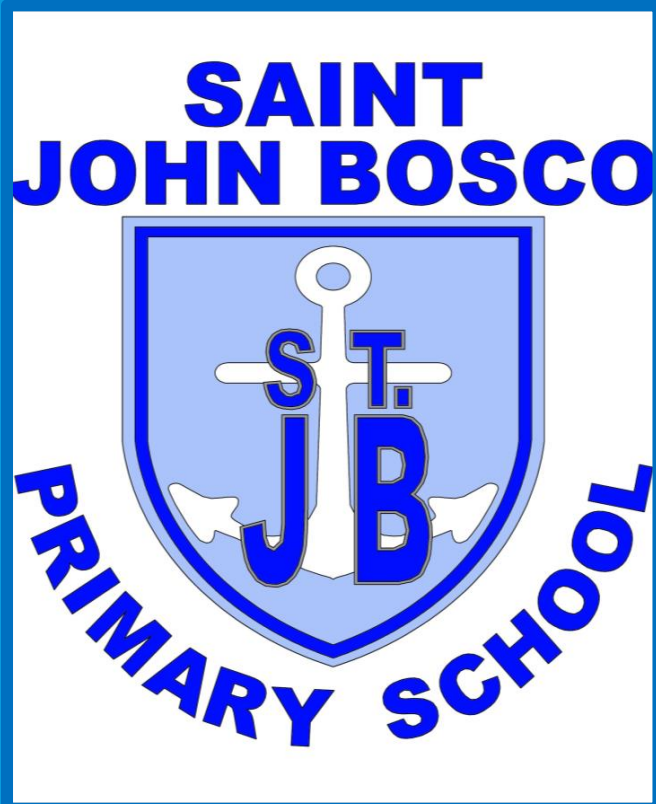


Breaktime for primary one children is from 10.30am – 10.45am.

You should provide your child with a healthy snack and a drink of water for break time.

Children will be supervised by adults in the playground at breaktime.

LUNCHTIME



All children in primaries 1 – 5 are entitled to free school meals.

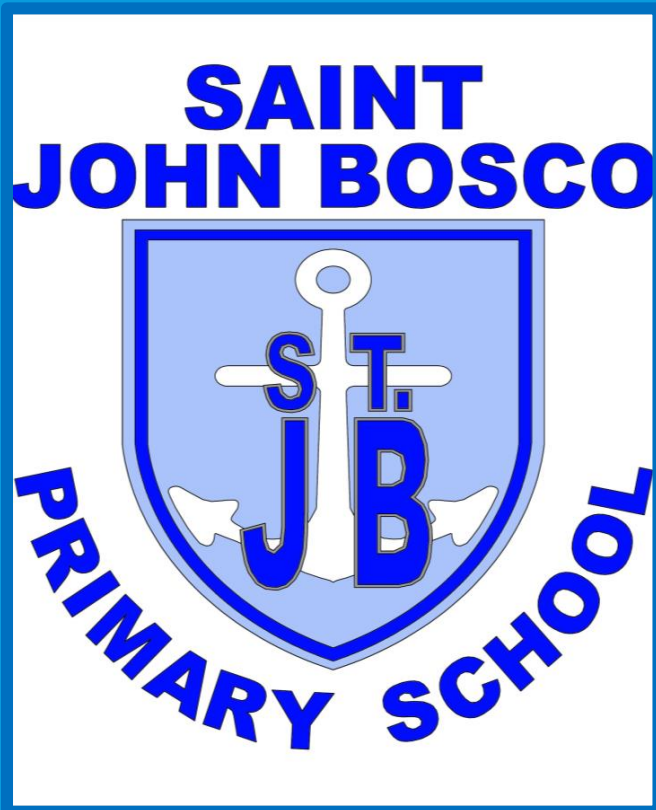
Children can choose to have a school lunch or to bring a packed lunch from home.

The school lunch menu will be sent home to parents at the beginning of the school session. If your child has any allergies or food intolerances, please inform the school.

Children choose their lunch option on the Promethean board in class each morning.

Children eat lunch in the lunch hall. Staff are in the lunch hall each day to support the children and ensure that they eat their lunch.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

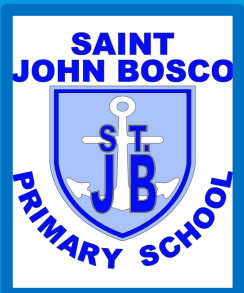


If your child will be travelling to school by school transport you should apply on the Renfrewshire council website. The link is below.

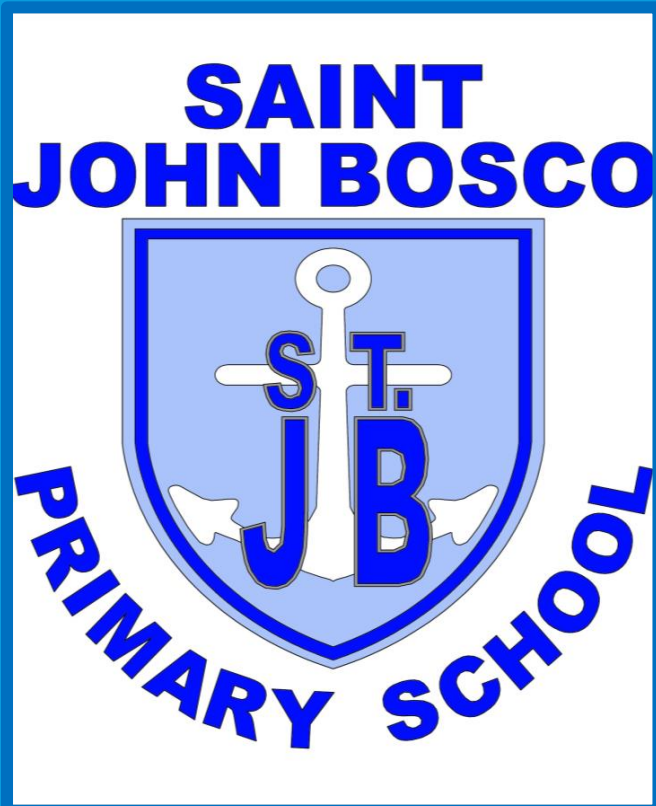

Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Bishopton, parish priest Father Ryan Black.

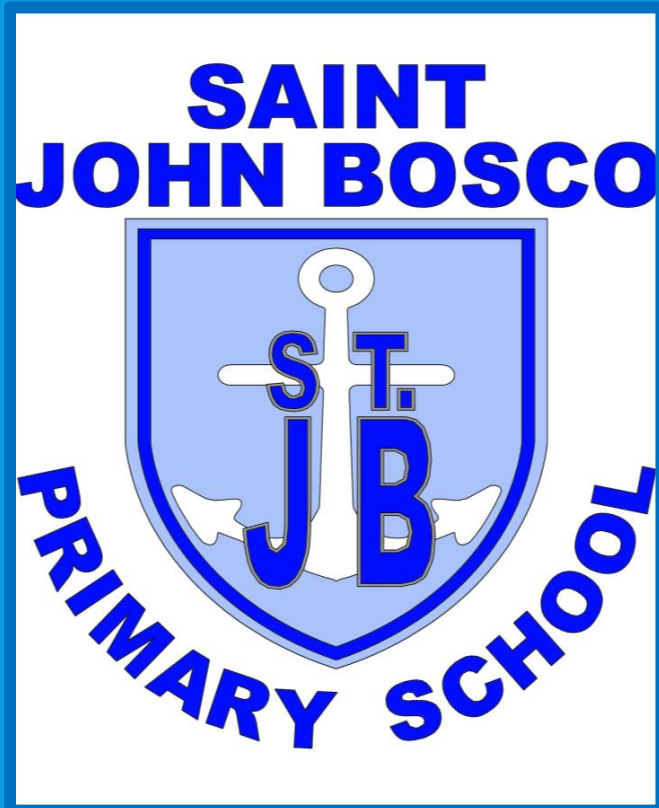
INDUCTION DAY 2

 - 2:30 Parents return to collect their child via main school entrance and are welcome in to meet their child's buddy.

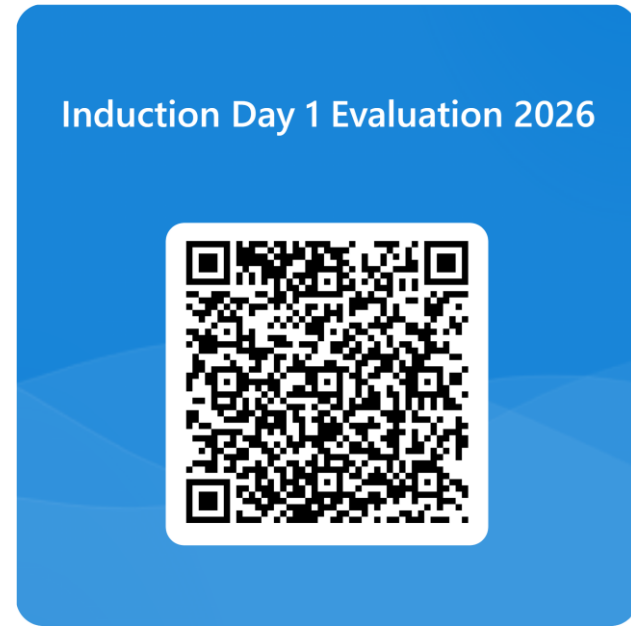
INDUCTION DAY 3

- 2:30 Parents return to collect their child via main school entrance.

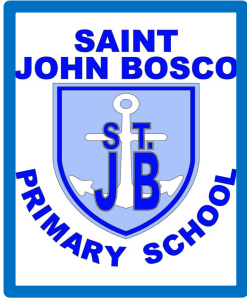
PARENT COUNCIL
