Primary – Secondary Transitions

Renfrewshire Transition Teachers

The role of Renfrewshire transition teachers is to support children with their literacy and numeracy learning through transition from primary to high school, so they can continue to make progress as they move into S1. They are particularly focusing on children who show potential to do well but who need short term input with some skills and concepts in literacy and/or numeracy. By receiving this short term intervention, children should then be better able to achieve well in their high school education.

Although the support is targeted, ALL P7 children will benefit from having a transition teacher working in their school and classroom. Transition teachers are experienced in both the P7 and S1 literacy and numeracy curriculums and as such, will be team teaching with both primary and secondary teachers. Transition teachers also bring consistency and a 'friendly face' for both children and their parents/ carers during this time of change.

Your Transition Teacher

The Transition Teacher for the St Andrew's cluster is Laura Rennie.

She will be working in the cluster primaries from January to June and then go with the children into their new high school in August, where they will remain until December.

You will meet Laura at parents' meetings and transition events over the course of the next few months. The transition teacher may also call you to introduce themselves personally if they would like to work with your child on particular skills or concepts and to get your thoughts on this.
