As an extension of this approach the RNRA parent group will provide support to parents where anxiety or conflict is an issue, especially as a barrier to engagement in learning.



3. Will increase your positive presence in your child's life, even when things feel really difficult

The RNRA Parent Group encourages parents to share their experiences, concerns and fears as well as their hopes with other people and to invite others to help and support them.



KEY CONCEPTS OF BBB RNRA PARENTING:

- Supporting your child
- Increasing parental presence
- De-escalating conflicts
- Announcing this commitment to your child or adolescent
- Recruiting and working with supporters
- Creating relational gestures that increase positive interactions between you and your child

DETAILS
