Dear Parent/ Carer,

A few final reminders to share with you prior to the First Holy Communion masses:

- Please arrive at the Cathedral 15 minutes before Mass begins.
- Entry to the Cathedral will be via the main doors (facing onto Glasgow Road).
- Each pupil can attend with a maximum of 5 other guests who have been identified on the track and trace information provided to the school. No other friends/relatives should attend.
- As per Government guidance, households cannot mix therefore social distancing must be adhered to within the row (2 metres apart).
- Physical distancing from other households, families and adults should be maintained at all times.
- Masks should be worn by everyone (including First Communicants) on entering the church and throughout the ceremony.
- Pupils should remove their masks as they go to receive Communion – these must be put back on as soon as they return to their seat. (This is the same for gloves if being worn).
- Fr. Joe has kindly asked that no photographs or videos are taken throughout the ceremony.
- At the end of Mass, you will be asked to exit via the side doors. If you wish to take photographs you can do so in the church grounds. Please do not re-enter the church. This is to allow for it to be cleaned.
- Please leave the church grounds as soon as you are finished.

On Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May the children will have an afternoon tea party to celebrate this special occasion. Thank you to the Parent Partnership for providing the children with a card, Maltesers, Walkers crisps and a Capri Sun. The children will bring their card home on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> May.

We are very much looking forward to sharing in this special occasion with you on Saturday.
