A few reminders


Staggered start and finish times will continue when we return in August. From Monday 16th August children in Primary 1,2 and 3 will start at 8.50am and finish at 2.50pm. The children in Primary 4,5,6 and 7 will start at 9am and finish at 3pm.

From August children should return wearing their full school uniform. This may include shirt and tie, white shirt, white polo shirt, grey skirt/pinafore, grey trousers, grey dress shorts, red/grey jumper or cardigan and dark coloured shoes. We also ask that children wear a warm jacket with a hood to school. For information, tartan dresses are not part of our school uniform.

As previously communicated, over the summer period the school will begin to be rewired. The project will continue into the new term. From August some of the classes (P1-5) will be decanted into a temporary classroom within the school for a short period of time to allow their classrooms to be rewired.
