A few reminders to help:

- Children should bring their luggage to school for the normal time (Gates open 8.45am).
- Entering through their normal doors.
- Luggage will be stored in the studio until the bus arrives.


Lockerbie Manor got in touch to say that unfortunately the Zip Wire activity will be out of use next week and instead the children will take part in AeroBall.
