Whole School

- Further implement the Children and Young People Act in relation to the introduction of the named person and child's plan;
- Access training opportunities in relation to the specific and general duty of the Equality Act 2010 and ensure the school is compliant with the Act;
- Extend nursery provision to 2 year olds;
- Improve procedures for reporting to parents including arrangements for parents' evenings and the format of written reports;
- Access relevant ASN training for staff.

Nursery to P7

- Formally introduce the restorative approach to promoting positive behaviour as part of the development of the nurture approach across the school;
- Organise workshops to support parents to engage with their children's learning;
- Further develop approaches to literacy teaching (cluster literacy project);
- Further develop approaches to numeracy teaching (local authority numeracy initiative);
- Develop curricular transitions across and within levels focusing on science;
- Develop approaches to ongoing and standardised assessment as part of the learning cycle;
- Undertake a review of curriculum rationale and delivery.



- Develop the protocol for working with mainstream nursery establishments with whom our PSADU pupils share placements.


