### Group B

We appreciate you will be keen to know what your child's new timetable will look like when pupils start to return to school from Wednesday 12 August, and we can now share this information.

We are all are very much looking forward to welcoming pupils back to **St Paul's Primary** and seeing our families again.

We understand the past few months have not been easy and our thanks go to you and your children for your patience and understanding.

This August will look different from any other year as schools will return to a model of blended learning – with pupils learning in school on some days and from home on others.

We know this is not ideal but are sure you will appreciate the situation is unprecedented. We have worked hard to develop a model which delivers the best possible learning experience while taking every precaution to ensure the safety of pupils and staff, in line with government advice.

We will ensure physical distancing is maintained as much as possible and will do this through reduced class sizes and using all available space throughout the school – however this obviously means not all pupils can be in school at the same time.

### **Your child's days in school**

In all Renfrewshire primary schools, half of children (Group A) will attend on a Monday and Tuesday, and the other half (Group B) on a Thursday and Friday. Wednesday will allow teachers to have their contractual non-class contact time and time for detailed planning for the week of face to face teaching and online tasks.

Your child will be in **Group B** and will attend on **Thursday and Friday each week, from Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August.**

School days will run from approximately 9am to 3pm but to ensure we maintain physical distancing at the start and end of the day, we will stagger start and finish times for different groups. We will be in touch with details of these for your child nearer the time.

We have tried to ensure all siblings attend on the same day wherever we can, however this has not always been possible. We realise we may not have been able to satisfy every family's particular circumstances and for this we both apologise and thank you for your understanding and support.



How long these arrangements continue depends entirely on advice and guidance from the Scottish Government. We will keep you updated on what that means for you and your family as and when that advice changes.

### **First week back**

The first week back will look different because schools open to pupils on Wednesday 12th August so this is a shorter school week.

We want to ensure everyone gets back to school at some point during that first week so arrangements for those three days will be different.

In that first week,

**Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August Primary 1 children in Group B will attend 12.30am – 3.00pm**

**Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August Primary 7 children in Group B will attend all day 8.45am – 2.45pm**

**Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August - only children in group A will attend. GROUP B SHOULD NOT ATTEND.**

**Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August - All children in Group B attend.**

From Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August your child should follow their staggered entry and exit time – this will be issued separately.

### **Other information**

We appreciate the new model throws up a lot of questions. We will be putting in place a new model of home learning, with teachers able to provide a level of support on the days your child is learning from home, and materials will be made available.

Childcare will be available for the children of key workers on the days they are not in school. You can find out more information on the council's website. We know the new model has implications for school transport and these are still being worked on.
