### Primary 7 Confirmation

Dear Parent / Carer,

As you know, in Primary 7 our children are presented for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In order to be presented for this Sacrament, the children must first be Baptised into the Catholic Church and have received the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

If you would like to present your child for the Sacrament of Confirmation, please bring to the office or send in a copy, of your child's baptism certificate. **Please submit these by 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021.**

*If you do not wish to present your child for this Sacrament, please let the school office know and we will ensure no further information is sent out to you.*

This year due to the current restrictions the children will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in St Paul's Church with Fr Jude. The dates for this are the evenings of Monday 24<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021. The numbers at each mass will depend on restrictions set out by the Scottish Government at the time. However, I thought at this stage the dates would be useful.

Sponsors – children should have chosen a sponsor. The sponsor **MUST BE OVER 16** years of age, a Catholic and not the parent of the child. A sponsor should be a person other than the parents, who will support the faith journey of the child. Many choose a Godparent, but this is not necessary. If you have any questions about a sponsor please contact the school and we will be happy to support you.

Miss Harrington, with the support of Mrs Gavin (RERC co-ordinator) will continue to prepare the children for this special Sacrament. As you know they have been working on this preparation and their Pope Francis Faith Award throughout Primary 6 and 7.
