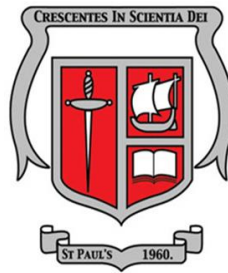

Dear Parent / Carer,

Thank you for your continued support and patience throughout yet another challenging session. Despite these challenges we have had a successful year. The children have made good progress in their learning, staff have engaged in a great deal of training, especially around online tools. As you know we also achieved Digital Schools Award and CRIS (Cyber Resilience & Internet Safety) award. You may also remember that last session we achieved a Gold Award for our Nurturing approaches across the school, being the first Renfrewshire Primary to do so. Mrs Grindlay and Miss Traynor will support teacher non-class contact time and planning and preparation time for our newly qualified teachers.

Mrs McLaughlin will support teacher non-class contact time and individual learning programmes across all Anchor classes.

Learning spaces identified above are based on normal class set-up. However, this may change depending on Government Guidance in August. As yet we do not know if we will still have socially distanced bubbles in place.

Staggered entry and exit - we do not yet know what the guidance will be come August. However, at the moment we have been told to plan for everything to remain the same for August. It is my intention to remain with staggered entry and exit but to merge them slightly. The children (and adults) are much better at following the procedures now, which is allowing us to get into school quicker.

Therefore, the plan in August will 2 groups instead of 3 groups.

We will have Group 1 at 8.45am - 2.45pm and a group 2 at 9am - 3pm.

Your child's group will be issued nearer the time via text message.
