Dear Parent / Carer,

I hope you all had a lovely summer break and managed to enjoy the fantastic Scottish weather. I hope you and your family are all safe and well and looking forward to the school session beginning again on Monday 16th August 2021.

You will have received a letter from the Director outlining some information and you will have heard in the news that school mitigations will largely remain the same, despite changes in the community.

For St Paul's we will be keeping all our safety mitigations in place for the first 6 weeks, as suggested by the Scottish Government, this will allow us to monitor the situation with hundreds of people back under one roof, for extended periods of time.

As explained in June 2021 we will have two staggered entry times instead of three. Your child's group will either be Group 1 – 8.45-2.45 or Group 2 9am-3pm. Your group has already been issued via text. Siblings have been grouped together. We will continue to take children in class by class and they should line up at their class sign with P5-7 standing at their areas on the grass.

One thing that will change is how we deliver lunch provision. Last session you will recall children ate lunch in their classes. As of Monday 16th August we will return to using the dining hall. We will have multiple sittings and ensure cleaning between each sitting. Children in P4-7 who have a packed lunch can eat outside if they wish. All P1-3 children will use the dinner hall. Children in the Anchor Base will continue to eat in class for a few weeks to support the transition back into the dining hall environment.

We ask for your continued support in terms of wearing masks when dropping children and collecting them and only parking in the car park if you have a disable badge.

I trust the return to school will be smooth and we look forward to reducing mitigations further in the coming weeks / months.

I look forward to seeing you all on Monday.
