FAMILY MASS

Covid Update

We will continue issuing "warn and inform" text messages when we have a positive case, as directed by the Scottish Government. These text messages are prescribed by the Scottish Government and contain the same information across all schools.

PLEASE NOTE: No pupil should come to school if they have symptoms which could be related to Covid. Please ensure a PCR test is taken and a negative result received and shown to the office

before returning to school. If anyone in the household has symptoms or is waiting on a PCR resultthe household MUST ISOLATE until a negative PCR result is returned.

Please continue to take LFD tests twice weekly and upload your results, as these will help with the spread of the virus.

We were waiting on an update from the Scottish Government during the October break, however, you will be aware from the news, that there has been no relaxation to the mitigations in school.

We will continue to operate with the same systems across our school community.



2 - Halloween

Children may dress up on Friday. I ask that you support us with NO MASKS, FACE PAINTS OR PROPS. These can often scare younger children or children who find disguises challenging. In order to ensure all our children feel included I ask that you respect these requests. This will allow all our children to enjoy the day while still feeling safe and secure at school. If children do not wish to dress up they can come in their own clothes - as usual no football tops. Children will have class parties with some treats.

Parents' Evening

Staff have now completed their telephone calls, providing you with an update on how your child/ren have settled into their new class. There are a few who have still not answered the call. Please note it will come from an unknown number when staff call.

Family Engagement

We are currently planning some family engagement activities to allow us to come together as a community and have some fun. We have delayed this till term 3 January - March in the hope they can be in person. Quiz time, knitting and art and craft are a few ideas so far. Further information to follow.
