Welcome

Mr Doherty Welcomed everyone and opened the meeting.

• Chairpersons Report

Mr Doherty attended a Parent Council Liaison Meeting at Renfrewshire Council on Tuesday 27 November. The focus was mainly on exam results in Renfrewshire schools and rising attainment. There was a discussion about Pupil Equity Fund and how important this has been in providing extra support in school for children. Attainment Challenge Authority Standards have risen across Renfrewshire Council. Mrs Mazzoni added Renfrewshire Council had very recently been inspected by Education Scotland and results are very positive although the report has not been published yet.

Treasurers Report

Mrs McAllister informed the group the Christmas Party Event was very successful and reported a profit of £400. There was a cost of £390.00 which included the DJ, vouchers and raffle prizes.

Mrs McAllister will collect application forms from the bank for Mr Doherty to enable him to become a Parent Council signatory. The Parent Council bank account is now digital.

• Head Teacher Report

Mrs Mazzoni explained the school was busy with Christmas preparations. Parents have been collecting tickets for the school show. Christmas parties have been organised and decorations will soon be appearing in the school.

P1/2 and P7 classrooms require new smartboards and these will be installed in the very near future. Mrs Mazzoni explained smartboards are very

expensive items and this necessary purchase means there will be no further ICT funds for school session 2018/2019.

Mrs Mazzoni reported to the group that the council have introduced a new financial system called Business World. It was installed in schools and some staff were issued with instructions on quick cards. There have been a few problems navigating the system across the authority, however it has been designed to streamline finance and procurement looking to the future.

Fundraising objectives for 2018/19

As discussed at the last meeting, Mrs Mazzoni had met with Mrs Lawson, Miss Young and other staff who got together as a group to discuss what the children would like in the playground. Big tyres, woodland areas and giant games had been discussed to make the playground a fun and exciting place for the children to be.
