Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to thank you for your continued partnership and cooperation throughout this school term. Our children have experienced many fun and engaging events which have contributed towards them increasing in confidence, developing skills and reaching many learning goals.

You will have seen information and photographs of these activities through your child's class dojo account. I hope you have thoroughly enjoyed the engagement and partnership through dojo this term.

I am very much looking forward to continuing to work with you all again in the new term.

Please note the school is opened to staff only on Monday 20 October and pupils return on Tuesday 21 October at 9am.

Parents' Evening

This is an opportunity for you to have valuable <u>face to face</u> time discussing your child's wellbeing and progress with staff who work with them closely each day and know them so well. I hope you find these conversations both informative and helpful. The meeting between you, your child and your child's teacher will take place in the classroom.

You should have received a letter home asking you to select your preferred option for your parents' evening appointment. Please complete this and return to your child's teacher by Friday 24 October. This provides you with the opportunity to select a time either on Wednesday 19 November between 5pm and 8pm or Thursday 20 November between 3pm and 6pm. Each appointment lasts approximately 10 minutes, and I must ask that you do your best to keep to the allocated timeslot as this allows the evening to run smoothly for everyone. Please do not hesitate to speak with Mrs Catherine McLean DHT or I if you feel the discussion you need to have requires more time. We would be more than happy to talk with you or arrange a further appointment with your child's class teacher.



Primary 1 Registration

This will take place <u>online</u> between Tuesday 4 November and Friday 7 November 2025 for children who will be expected to begin primary 1 in August 2026. If your child turns 5 between 1 March 2025 and 29 February 2026 you should complete online registration. If your child is still 4 in August 2025 you can apply for an additional year of ELCC. Please speak to your child's key worker or the Senior Early Learning and

Childcare Officer if you think your child would benefit from an additional year at nursery. This will be considered where there are reasons to suggest that it would be in your child's best interests and a deferred application will be made to the local authority.

What should you do if you are unable to complete online registration?

You should make contact with the school and make an appointment to attend in person. This will allow you to complete the registration process within the suggested timescale to secure your child's place.

What will you need to register your child at school?

During the registration process, you will be required to produce the following documentation to support your child's entry to school:

- 1. Child's full Birth Certificate
- 2. Most recent Council Tax Notice or if not currently resident in the property either a concluded missive or a signed and witnessed tenancy agreement/lease. We will check the information provided with other Council departments and our audit colleagues; this may include visiting your home to confirm residence. We may also check your address again prior to a school term commencing and if we suspect fraud we may rescind your place and refer the matter to the Procurator Fiscal.
- 3. Child Benefit Statement. (In the event that a Child Benefit Statement is not available, a Driving Licence or a Bank Statement/utility bill showing transactions over the most recent 3 months and the applicant's address may be accepted). Or if appropriate to current circumstances: Court Order / Looked After Child/Foster carer document(s).
- 4. Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate if your child has been baptised. Please note this is not required to attend St. Peter's Primary.



You should be able to access further information by searching 'apply for a place at school' on Renfrewshire Council website.

Breakfast Club

This is now available for all children who wish to attend. Please collect a consent form from the school office if you would like your child to attend any day of the week. There is a small charge of 50p each morning for some toast, cereal, fruit, milk, and water.

Tempest Photographer

There will be an opportunity for children to have school photographs taken on Tuesday 21 October. This will be for individuals and families. You can decide if you want to purchase the photographs taken. All proofs will be sent home for you to make your decision.

School Values

Our children regularly talk about our school values and what it means to be kind, respectful, responsible, fair and honest. We focus on how to demonstrate this in school and in the community. It would be helpful if you could regularly talk to your child at home about our school values to reinforce the message that they are ambassadors of our school and ambassadors of their family. Please encourage them to continue to make us proud every day.

School Attendance

It is extremely important that your child is able to attend school. During the unfortunate times when your child is unable to attend, I ask that you please contact the school office before 9.30am to let us know why. If we do not hear from you we will send a text in the hope that you respond immediately. If we have no contact from home and your child has still not arrived at school by 10am you may receive a home visit from a member of school staff to check that everyone is safe and well. I appreciate your cooperation in letting us know when and why your child cannot attend. My hope for this year is that everyone enjoys good health alongside many happy days at school.
