Language and Literacy

Reading - Children will be practicing our reading skills through our Big Cat and Dandelion reading books. These books will help to develop reading fluency skills, pace and comprehension skills.

Phonics and Spelling Words - We will be focusing on phonics rules for our spelling words this term. Children will practice reading and writing these words in class through games and working in our jotters, and these words will also be sent home to practice.

Writing -

Children will participate in 'talk for writing' lessons. Children have short burst writing lessons based around a story and build up a 'toolkit' to enhance writing skills. Children are also participating in class novel activities and we soon will start Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

Maths and Numeracy

To develop maths skills this term the children will work in a variety of ways, including active learning, playing games, using ICT, number talks and completing written work. Activities will be differentiated to suit the needs of the children.

Topics to be covered in Term 1 will be: Multiplication and division, expressions and equations, fractions and data analysis. Mrs Everett will be working with the children on a Friday to develop skills in the Properties of 2D & 3D shape.

Health and Wellbeing

Our P.E. days are on Wednesday and Thursday - please ensure your child comes prepared for P.E and removes all jewellery. Long hair should be worn up and pulled away from your child's face. We will be focusing on games, football and dancing. Children will be participating in outdoor PE sessions and will be participating in the Daily Mile Initiative when weather permits. Children will also continue to participate in weekly lessons developing their emotion resilience, as well as anti-bullying, internet safety and mindfulness.

Religious Education - 'This is Our Faith'

This term we will be learning about the Bible, bible stories and people from the bible. We will be learning about the lives of Saints as well as learning caring for our world. Primary 4 have started their journey towards making the sacrament of reconciliation and holy communion.

Technologies

The children will have weekly opportunities to use a range of ICT equipment to enhance digital learning skills as well as word processing skills. They will also use maths & language games to consolidate their learning, including SumDog and Teach Your Monster to Read.

Expressive Arts

Art - We will be developing our skills across art and design focusing on the use of colour, line and using a variety of media. We will be creating seasonal art for Spring as well as learning about famous artists.

Drama - Drama will be used throughout the curriculum to support learning. Children will learn different Drama conventions and will be able to explore these through different techniques.

Music - Music will be used to enhance learning activities during Spanish, RE, P.E and Drama lessons. We will also be using Charanga to enhance our music lessons. Children are taking beat buddies lessons for 6 weeks which will enhance musical skills.

Spanish

This term we will develop the children's confidence and skills in talking and listening in Spanish. The learning will be focused on classroom objects, days of the week and months of the year. Spanish lessons will involve lots of games and songs.

Social Studies

We are also focusing on Scotland and The Rainforest throughout this term. Topic work links all areas of the curriculum together and will have a particular focus on Social Studies, Art, Drama and Technologies.

Science

Children will be focusing on science on a Friday with Mrs Everett where they will be learning about, Processes of the Planet; the changing states of water, Forces; magnetic materials, Body Systems and Cells.
