Language and Literacy

Reading - We enjoy reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction books from the Big Cat reading scheme. These books help us to develop our reading fluency skills, pace and comprehension skills. We are learning to put our blending skills to practise to read our books. We are reminded that every book has a title, author, illustrator and blurb. This term, we will also be reading the "Katie Morag" books as part of our topic!

Writing - We are learning to tell a story using the Talk for Writing approach. This term we will also be learning a non-fiction Talk for Writing unit on instructional writing, where we will focus on a Scottish recipe. We continue to enhance and explore writing in our play.

Maths and Numeracy

To develop our maths skills this term, the children will work in a variety of ways, including active learning, playing games, using ICT, SEAL maths and completing written work. Activities will be differentiated to suit the needs of the children. Children will continue to develop mathematical skills and language through play.

Topics to be covered in Term 2 will be: Multiplication and division, fractions, time, pattern and relationships.

Health and Wellbeing

Our P.E. days are on **Monday, Tuesday** and a **Wednesday**. We will be focusing on games and ball skills. Children will be participating in outdoor PE sessions and will be in the Daily Mile Initiative when weather permits. Children will now participate in the Emotion Works programme with weekly lessons developing their emotional resilience.

Religious Education - 'This is Our Faith'

This term we will be learning about The Holy Family, Jesus and Lent. As it approaches, we will prepare for Holy Week and Easter.

Technologies

The children will have weekly opportunities to use a range of ICT equipment to enhance digital learning skills as well as word processing skills. They will also use maths & language games to consolidate their learning.

Expressive Arts

Art - We will be developing our skills across art and design focusing on the use of colour, line and using a variety of media. We will be creating seasonal art for Burns Day, Spring and Easter, and we will also be studying famous artists.

Drama - Drama will be used throughout the curriculum to support learning, where children will learn different Drama conventions.

Music - Music will be used to enhance learning activities during Spanish, RE, P.E and Drama lessons.

Spanish

This term we will develop the children's confidence and skills in talking and listening in Spanish. The learning will be focused on greetings, numbers 0-10, and colours. Spanish lessons will involve lots of games and songs.

Social Studies

This term our topic is Katie Morag. Topic work links all areas of the curriculum together and will have a particular focus on Social Studies, Art and Technologies.

Science

We will be taking part in some experiments and spend time learning about and observing seasonal changes and exploring the world through science. We will have a focus on space this term.
