It's that time of year again where we look forward to our annual Health and Wellbeing activities! This time, we have split activities across several weeks in June to ensure that the children have a good variety of tasks, without too much disruption to classroom learning. ### **God's Loving Plan**

Primaries 1 – 7 will focus on God's Loving Plan lessons this term. The Scottish Catholic Education Service devised 'God's Loving Plan' which is the revised programme for relationship education in primary schools. The lessons are designed to teach children how to develop healthy attitudes to their bodies and to all human life so that they can form loving relationships, according to God's loving plan for their lives. ### **Outdoor Activity Days**

Active Schools are providing us with coaches to deliver some outdoor sport sessions across the school. Primaries 2 – 6 will take part in activities on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June. Primary 7 will have an outdoor activity day on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June. School uniform should be worn but leggings/shorts/joggers would be better for the children. Please ensure they have suitable footwear for outdoor activities.

### **World Cup Celebration Day**

Mrs Duckett is planning a celebration day to kick off the World Cup! Classes will take part in a morning of football stations to practise and develop their football skills. Please remember that football strips for favourite clubs/teams are not allowed to be worn in school. Children can wear any national football team strips or something blue or tartan for Scotland. Please make sure that your child has suitable clothing and footwear for activities as these will take place outdoors (weather permitting!) and so jackets/hats/sun cream is advised. Classes will also take part in some fun football related tasks in class to explore the World Cup.
