In addition to the members, we have a core group of fantastic helpers who support the events.

More members and helpers are needed to deliver the full programme of events this coming school year. Following some promotion of the PC at the P1 Inductions in May/June 2023, AH received notes of interest from 5 parents/carers wishing to receive more information on the work of the PC. AH contacted all 5 on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023 and hopefully this will result in new members joining.

The objectives of Todholm Parent Council are:

- to work in partnership with the school to create a welcoming school which is inclusive for all parents/guardians/carers.
- to promote partnership between the school, its pupils, all its parents, guardians, or carers (the Parent Forum) and the wider community.
- to develop and engage in activities which support the education and welfare of the pupils.
- to represent the views of parents/guardians/carers on the education provided by the school and other matters affecting the education and welfare of the pupils.

The aims of Todholm Parent Council are to:

- communicate with the wider Parent Forum on issues relating to the school.
- represent the views of the wider Parent Forum so, for example, if you come
  to us to discuss a point, if it is within our remit, we can talk to the relevant
  parties on your behalf; and
- raise funds to support added-value activities for the benefit of the pupils.
  Those are activities that are not funded from the Renfrewshire Council
  allocated budget for the school e.g. outdoor seating, Book Fair, sound system,
  P7 leavers gifts, Halloween discos, Christmas parties, P1-4 and P5-7 events,
  P1 book bags, talent show prizes etc.

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The PC meet formally, within the school, at least once each term which equates to four meetings per year. All minutes are now shared by the school on ClassDojo and on the PC page of the school website.

Out with the formal meetings, additional meetings are held on an ad hoc basis, e.g. fundraising meetings to co-ordinate event planning.

The formal meetings involve the members of the Parent Council and a representative body from the school – this is normally Head Teacher and Depute Head Teachers.

From time to time there may be other parties in attendance, and this would happen when there was something specific to address on the agenda that required input from an outside party e.g. representative from Amey or Renfrewshire Council, pupils etc.

We are open to face-to-face communication from the parent forum and have a Facebook page and an email address for correspondence.


#### 2022/2023 Activity

- Summer Disco free event


At the outset of the school year, and after discussion with the school, the PC agreed to financially support 2 events which would be free of charge to all pupils.

#### PC Events – 2022/2023 – Income and Expenditure/Profit




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In terms of funding back to the school, the PC supported a number of requests totalling £8,422.92:
