The Career Pathways event being held within Trinity High School on Thursday 1st February from 6pm until 8pm.

The evening is open to all pupils, parents and carers but will be particularly useful to those making curriculum choice options (S2 and S4/5) or young people thinking of leaving school and unsure of post school destinations.

The informal event will provide the opportunity to network with representatives from various sectors such as construction, engineering, hospitality, NHS Scotland, Police and Fire Services to help inform young people of the employment opportunities available within each sector and the skills these employers are looking for. Course Leads from West College Scotland and Strathclyde University will also be available to provide information on further and higher education. In addition, Skills Development Scotland, Invest Renfrewshire, and Street League will be present throughout the evening to discuss career opportunities including third sector and social enterprise options.

Teaching staff will also be present throughout the evening to provide information on courses, pathways, and progression routes within their subject and related career opportunities.
