SQA Exam Results

All young people will now have received their National Qualification results and we are hopeful that they are happy with their achievements.

Learner submitted Priority Appeals have now closed for SQA. Staff will review these and ensure they are submitted by 21st August. Candidates who submitted an appeal online will receive an update as to the outcome in due course.

All other Appeals can be reviewed in school with Pastoral Teachers. The attached form should be completed once a conversation has taken place and submitted to Depute Head Teacher for entry. The deadline to submit an Appeal is: Monday 26th August.

SQA Appeals

Once you submit an appeal, a senior marker will carry out a marking review of your SQA-marked assessments.

This is not a re-mark.

A marking review checks that:

- all parts of your SQA-assessments have been marked
- the marking is in line with national standards
- the marks given for each answer have been totalled correctly and
- the correct result has been entered on our system.

Please note that after being reviewed, **your result could stay the same, go up or go down.**
