ALL SAINTS DAY AND NOVEMBER REMEMBRANCE

During the month of November, the Roman Catholic Church has a tradition of praying for the Holy Souls. Since the 16th Century, the Catholic Church has assigned entire months to special devotions. As a reminder of our duty to pray for the suffering faithful in Purgatory, the Church has dedicated the month of November to the Holy Souls.

The Holy Souls are those who have died in a state of grace, but who are not yet free from all sin. They are certain of entering Heaven, but first they must suffer in Purgatory. The Holy Souls cannot help themselves because for them the night has come, when no man can work (John 9:4). It is our great privilege of brotherhood that we can lessen their time of separation from God by our prayers, good works, and, especially, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. During this month all RE classes will visit the Oratory to take part in a November remembrance service.
