### St Edmund of East Anglia

St Edmund of East Anglia was born around the year 841 AD and to the throne as the King of East Anglia when he was just 14 yea received his coronation on Christmas Day in 855 AD, a ceremon by Bishop Saint Humbert of Elmham.

Edmund was a remarkable ruler who held deep concerns for the justice of his people, as well as his own spiritual growth.

Tragically, during one of the many armed conflicts with invading he was captured. In a cruel demand, he was ordered to surrend subjects to the pagan invaders, but he staunchly refused, standi faith. Ultimately, he met his end as a martyr.

Saint Edmund met his death through a brutal ordeal that involve beaten, whipped, and shot with arrows, to the extent that he app covered in them, resembling a hedgehog.

His execution occurred in Hoxne, Suffolk, England, on November He was buried in Hoxne, and his relics underwent several relocation centuries.

Born Caterina Offreducia, Agnes was the younger sister of Saint her first follower. When Caterina left home two weeks after Clare departure, their family attempted to bring her back by force. The drag her out of the monastery, but her body suddenly became s that several knights could not budge it. Her uncle Monaldo tried her but was temporarily paralyzed. The knights then left Caterina in peace. Saint Francis himself gave Clare's sister the name Agne she was gentle like a young lamb.Agnes matched her sister in d prayer and in willingness to endure the strict penances that char the Poor Ladies' lives at San Damiano. In 1221, a group of Bened in Monticelli near Florence asked to become Poor Ladies. Saint ( Agnes to become abbess of that monastery. Agnes soon wrote letter about how much she missed Clare and the other nuns at S Damiano. After establishing other monasteries of Poor Ladies in Italy, Agnes was recalled to San Damiano in 1253, as Clare lay d months later Agnes followed Clare in death, and was canonized

St. Clement I was Bishop of Rome in the late first century AD. He is listed by Tertullian as the bishop of Rome, holding office from 88 AD to his death in first Apostolic Father of the Church.

Few details are known about Clement's life. Clement was said to have been Peter the Apostle, and he is known to have been a leading member of the o the late 1st century.

Clement was banished from Rome to the Chersonesus during the reign of Trajan and was set to work in a stone quarry. Finding on his arrival that the suffering from lack of water, he knelt in prayer. Looking up, he saw a lamb of where the lamb had stood and struck the ground with his pickaxe, releasing stream of clear water.

St. Andrew Düng-Lac and his Companions Andrew Dung-Lac, a Catholic convert ordained to the priesthood, wa people martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. Members of the group gave their lives for Christ in the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries beatification during four different occasions between 1900 and 1955 canonized during the papacy of Saint John Paul II.

Christianity came to Vietnam through the Portuguese. Jesuits opened permanent mission at Da Nang in 1615. They ministered to Japanese had been driven from Japan.

Severe persecutions were launched at least three times in the 19th c six decades after 1820, between 100,000 and 300,000 Catholics were subjected to great hardship. Around the age of fourteen, she moving vision of Mary and the infant Jesus, and she decided to become a Christ intelligent and gifted. When the emperor Maxentius began persecuting Christian visited him to denounce his cruelty.

Rather than order her execution, Maxentius summoned fifty orators and philos her. However, Catherine was moved by the power of the Holy Spirit and spoke e defence of her faith. Her words were so moving that several converted to Christ immediately executed. Unable to defeat her rhetorically or to intimidate her inter belief, the emperor ordered her to be tortured and imprisoned.
