



### Home—School Communication: Groupcall Xpression App

Over the next few weeks we will begin to use the Groupcall Xpressions App to communicate with Parents / Carers. Groupcall Xpressions is created, supported and maintained by the award-winning school communication company Groupcall Limited.

Xpressions is completely free of charge to you and can be installed on your mobile phone or tablet. It supports both Apple iOS and Android devices.

If you have children in different schools and those schools also use Groupcall Xpressions, you will be able to view information on multiple children within the same app and same login.

It is vital that we have your correct mobile number and email address on our school database to ensure you can use Xpressions as soon as it is available - you will need these details to log into Xpressions. You'll also need to make sure you keep these details up to date in future to maintain access to the service.
