Amen."

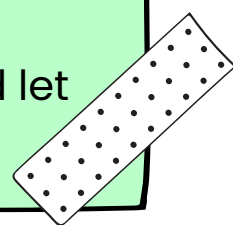
"God, may my sacrifice of today of
