

Reporting Processes (Next Session)

During this session we have consulted pupils, parents and staff on how we communicate academic progress. This has been a full consultation and I am grateful to everyone who took the time to respond to the survey or attend focus groups. Following this discussion we are looking to introduce the new format of reporting (below) for each year group:

- 1x in-person parents evening in the school per session
- 2 x academic progress report (tracking) with a Pastoral comment per session
- 1 x “virtual” parents evening per session

This model will not only increase the number of opportunities that we have to report on the progress of your child but also allows us make each discussion / report more bespoke and linked to the progress and support available for your child. We will also build in a programme of learner progress conversations across the school next session.

I am hopeful that you will agree this is further evidence of our school reviewing procedures on a regular basis to ensure we support everyone to ‘achieve excellence together’. I am more than happy to discuss this new format with anyone who wishes to contact me at the school.

I will issue a reporting schedule for next session before the end of this session.
